"If you had Faith the Size of a Mustard Seed..."

What would you do if you had faith the We all struggle with difficulties in the size of a mustard seed? Do you? Have faith the size of a mustard seed? That's pretty small. Maybe you have more faith than that. Maybe you think you have a lot of faith but really, do you? Jesus is saying that if you had ONLY that much faith, no bigger than a mustard seed, you would be able, through the grace of God, to do things that are virtually impossible.

I think the point is to get us to shift our thinking away from the natural world and the way the world thinks and to think much bigger, to think beyond space and time, to think of the spiritual world, to use our imaginations.

Through its own efforts, the human mind is able to have a knowledge of God the Creator by considering created things. It can know of his existence, but it cannot understand the mystery of his intimate life. Divine revelation tells us that God is Triune, but it does not show us the Trinity. It makes us know that God gives us grace, but we cannot see grace. And exactly because we cannot see, in order to adhere to divine mysteries, we must We all recite the Creed, "I believe in God,

miracle Jesus performs, he always asked for an act of faith? "Do you believe I can do this?" "Yes Lord!" "Let it and let human considerations invade be done to you according to your faith." our life as if God had nothing to do with (MT. 9:28-29)

When faith was sincere the miracle took place immediately. "Be of good heart daughter" he said to the hemorrhaging woman, "your faith has made you whole." (Mt. 9:22) Jesus never said, by my power I heal you, but always, "your faith."





