grace? I'm not speaking of sacramental offered to him in this encounter with his grace; I'm thinking about the grace that fellow slave. comes through an encounter with another. Moments of grace come when we find ourselves in uncomfortable situations, usually concerning another person. The situation may be difficult and yet, in that moment, there is an offer of grace and often it is refused. We sometimes run away from grace because to receive grace is painful because it involves change and we don't like change. Grace, freely given in moments that are forged in trial and difficulties, will knock us off our feet if we allow it. We come out of ourselves and bring ourselves to the other and, as difficult as the situation might have been, we are so much better off for it.

The slave that was forgiven his debt by the master (Matthew 18:21-35) was offered a great moment of grace. And what did he do with it? He ran away from it because it would have required that he open up his heart, that he has a transformation. He had no idea of the gift he was given and so he can't bring himself to forgive the small debt that was owed to him.

Think about this: Where do we find He's not ready to accept the grace

We often miss opportunities for grace because we are so blind sometimes. Amazing Grace how sweet the sound that saved a wretch like me. I once was lost but now I'm found, was blind but now I see. Let's face it, we are broken. We've been broken since the time of Adam and Eve. Each of us suffers our own brokenness, no matter who we are or how much money we have. We all suffer. Being the natural state of affairs, brokenness is simply an opportunity to mend.

We live by mending. We need to lean into our brokenness, accept it, embrace it, and offer it to Christ. And then we can accept the glue that mends our lives: the grace of God.

Christ wasn't broken but he became broken for us. He's on the cross, leaning into his suffering. He embraces it. He makes it meaningful. He uses it for our salvation. He cries out to his Father, "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do!" In his great moment of grace, he did not refuse. Neither should we.


