### The Paradox of Christianity III



Here we are at the end of our liturgical year, the end of Ordinary Time, the end of the Gospel of Luke, the end of time. That's precisely what the Church tends to focus on at the end of the liturgical year. The end times. Focusing on these scripture readings should lead us to reflect on our own end. By that, I mean how it will end for us when we die, and the purpose for which we were made.

And I suppose the reason I am writing again about the paradoxes Christianity is because I'm attempting to have you look deeper into the Catholic faith and help you discover the mystical nature of Christ and his teachings. Jesus is at odds with the physical world, the world we know and live in. Christians are at odds with the world as well. It's not enough to try to understand reality at face value. We must look deeper, to what is unseen, to what is beyond the seen. Because that's where reality lives.

It sounds like a paradox. This is true not just in the spiritual realm, but it is how science is beginning to explain the universe. In all the universe, less than .1% is matter - the stuff we can see, smell, feel or taste. The rest of it has yet to be explained by science but it seems that more scientists are concluding that the universe can only be explained by the existence of something that you might call God.

The paradox here is that what we humans think of as reality, is miniscule compared to what reality is. And that is why what Jesus speaks of and teaches seems so paradoxical to us - he knows reality, he created reality and he places

us in reality to be with him forever. He is straightening out our false notions of reality. He's teaching us to live well and according to his precepts. He's giving us what we need to guide our immortal souls to be one with him and in him. He tells his stories and parables to help us to avoid the traps of a carnal existence on earth, reminding us that, yes, we are flesh but that we are also spirit.

He wants us to look past the passions and desires that promise us something they can't deliver. They offer us temporary pleasures that fade like morning flowers that are dried up and gone by evening. Fleeting temporary are the solutions we use to fill our emptiness.

Jesus wants us to trust him with what is not so obvious to us, things that will make our life full of joy, even through our struggles and pain because what he shows us is the reality of his existence.

We can only begin to understand any of this if we have a sense of wonder. We need to use our imagination if we're going to understand Catholic doctrine. That's a paradox. How can we begin to relate to the Trinity, to the Mystical Body of Christ, that God became one of us, if we take everything at face value? We can't. We need a sense of wonder and imagination and poetry. Like the Psalms.

"You, O Lord, are my lamp My God who lightens my darkness." (Psalm 18:30)






