The Mustard Seed

Have you noticed that tiny mustard seed that has been growing into a tree in every Sunday bulletin for the last eight weeks? Did you ever ask yourself why it was there? Did it have meaning? Well, yes, it does have meaning. Today we are launching a new fundraising initiative, called

Mustard Seed.

We are reaching out to our parishioners, yes, but we want to go beyond the parish, to our neighbors, family and friends, in search of funds to help pay for our church basement renovations. Our basement is being designed to attract people from the neighborhood and surrounding area to participate in the life of the church by joining us for coffee, attending concerts, renting the hall for all kinds of good, healthy activities.

For this to happen we will need to invest a substantial amount of money. And that's exactly what Mustard Seed is: an investment in the future of Our Lady of Lourdes.





Appointment of The Most Reverend Richard W. Smith as Twelfth Archbishop of Vancouver

Early on Tuesday morning, the Vatican announced that Pope Francis has appointed **Archbishop Richard W. Smith**, currently Archbishop of Edmonton, as the next Archbishop of Vancouver. Archbishop Smith will succeed **Archbishop J. Michael Miller, CSB** who has served the archdiocese since 2009. Plans for the installation of the new archbishop are not yet finalized, but it will likely take place in late May.



During this time of transition, we give thanks for Archbishop Miller and his service to the Church and welcome Archbishop Smith, who will be joining our community soon. Please continue to keep these shepherds close in prayer in the months ahead

Ash Wednesday Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, the start of Lent, is this week! Lent is a beautiful season, a gift, to help us focus more on God. There will be **two Masses**: one at **8:30 am** and the other at **7 pm**. Come and receive the Lord in the Eucharist and the ashes on the forehead. A reminder that all Catholics ages 18 to 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday (and Good Friday) and all Catholics, ages 14 and up are required to abstain from eating meat.

Giving Up Something for Lent

During Lent we typically "give up something". Why do we do this? Do we have to give something up? During Lent, we give up good things in exchange for better things, things that draw our attention toward our Lord, Jesus Christ. We can give up a favourite food or activity, chocolate or Netflix, for example. As we do so we can take a look at ourselves and ask, where are my priorities? Is God first in my life? Do I want him more than I want this? Instead of, or perhaps in addition to "giving up", we could "add something", spending extra time in prayer, daily reading of Scripture or the lives of the saints, or increasing our charitable donations. Part of the point of these Lenten practices is to open our hearts to God, train our minds to pursue him more, and set aside the time to do so.


