Stewardship Reflection -Easter Sunday Sunday of the Resurrection of Christ

This Is the Night!

This is the most beautiful night. I'm speaking of course, of the night when Jesus rose from the dead and left the tomb. There is a song that is sung immediately after the paschal candle enters the darkened church at the beginning of the Easter Vigil. The song is called the Exultet (or the Easter Proclamation) and is sung solo and acapela by the glowing, warm light of the paschal candle and the vigil candles being held by the congregation. It's a beautiful song and a beautiful experience.

The Easter Proclamation sings of the deeper reasons that Easter is so special for all of mankind. I'll reprint a few of its verses here:

This is the night

When once you led our forebears, Israel's children,

From slavery in Egypt

And made them pass dry-shod through the Red Sea.

This is the night

That with a pillar of fire

Banished the darkness of sin.

This is the night

That even now, through the world, Sets Christian believers apart from worldly vices

And from the gloom of sin, Leading the way to grace And joining them to his holy ones.

This is the night

When Christ broke the prison-bars of death

And rose victorious from the underworld.

Our birth would have been no gain, had we not been redeemed. O wonder of your humble care for us! O love, O charity beyond all telling, To ransom a slave, you gave away your

O truly necessary sin of Adam, Destroyed completely by the Death of Christ!

O happy fault

that earned so great, so glorious a redeemer!

O truly blessed night,

Worthy alone to know the time and hour

When Christ rose from the underworld!

This is the night

Of which it is written:

The night shall be bright as day, Dazzling is the night for me,

And full of gladness.

The sanctifying power of this night wickedness, washes faults Dispels away,

Restores innocence to the fallen, and joy to mourners,

Drives out hatred, fosters concord, and brings down the mighty.

On this, your night of grace, O holy Father,

Accept this candle, a solemn offering, The work of bees and your servants'

An evening sacrifice of praise, This gift from your most holy Church.

Rejoice! He is Risen! Just as he said! Happy Easter!




