The Devout Life

devout life? That is, is your life devoted to grace by our witness, by our attitude. living out your belief in God? Perhaps We show and share the fruits of the you think that "I keep the faith, I believe in God, I go to Mass on Sunday – but I'm no saint. I live in the world and the world has demands. I work with people of different faiths and even no faith at all." You might think, "How can I be praying all the time? I just live an ordinary life, trying to get by, trying not to hurt anyone, trying not to get hurt. I work, take care of my family, I'm tired, try to relax, maybe have a little fun."

Sure, that's a natural way of looking at it. But I ask you this: if you scratched the surface and searched a little deeper, would you not find in your heart, a desire for devotion? A desire to love God more and to know his love better? Of course you do because our souls, yours and mine, are completely restless until we're at home with God. But we're not home yet, we're still on the pilgrimage, and on this journey through this soup called space and time, we must keep the end in mind. That end is to be with God forever when our pilgrimage on earth is finished, when our race is run!


The two visions proposed here are not mutually exclusive. Everyone receives a personal call from God. Each of us has gifts, charisms, duties, circumstances that are not the same as anyone else's. What Jesus is asking of us is that, wherever we are in this world, whatever job we have, whatever our family circumstances, we are called to love.

But what is this love? And how does it show itself? How do we express it? Living in a harsh world does not deprive us of the ability to will the good of others, even those who are our enemies. Working in a secular environment, even where sin abounds, the grace of God abounds more. That grace is present perhaps due to our presence.

Do you ever think of yourself as living a Living among others, we share God's Holy Spirit: charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity.

> If these fruits are seen in us by others in our lives, we must be living a devout life. In the midst of hard work, difficult times, even tragedy, if we can maintain our peace and our joy, we are bearing witness to the greatest love, the love Christ has for all of us.

> Lest you think I'm on my high horse telling you to become as holy as I am, I offer a quote from St. Francis de Sales' Introduction to the Devout Life: "It is true, my dear reader, that I write about the devout life although I myself am not devout. Yet, it is certainly not without a desire of becoming so..."



Brothers and Sisters, we are not called to be successful, we are called to be faithful. Let us commit ourselves to faithfully loving God and our neighbor better every day and we will be living a devout life.
