Our plans to renovate the basement include an important feature - bringing back the windows that were boarded up over fifty years ago. Windows allow the light to come in. Beautiful daylight. Allowing daylight in through the windows will make our church basement far more appealing than an enclosed space filled with artificial light. It will bring life to the activities and events taking place in our basement. We plan on installing 8 windows along the north and south sides at a cost of \$10,000 each. We are dependent on your support to make this happen. All parishioners are encouraged to donate as participation is just as important, if not more so, than the amount given. 
Parish Religious Education Program - PREP




