

Divine Mercy Sunday

The message of The Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us. He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others.

In the Divine Mercy image Jesus is clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in blessing.

His left hand is touching His garment in the area of the Heart, from where two large rays came forth, one red and the other pale.

The two rays denote Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls. These two rays issued forth from the depths of Jesus' tender mercy when his agonized Heart was opened by a lance on the Cross.

This Jubilee Year, the Vatican has designated Holy Doors exclusively at the four major papal basilicas in Rome to highlight the unity of the universal Church and to invite Catholics worldwide to make the traditional pilgrimage to Rome. There are no Holy Doors in Vancouver, though Catholics can still obtain the Jubilee Indulgence by following the instructions outlined at rcav.org/jubilee.
