Stewardship Reflection Fifth Sunday of Lent

There's A Change A'Comin

Vancouver abortion and reproductive health clinic to shut after 35 years

(Vancouver Sun headline, March 28, 2025)

The Elizabeth Bagshaw clinic told Vancouver Coastal Health it'll be closing its doors at the end of June 2025.

I've only been involved in the prolife movement for about fourteen years. For many others it has been twice or even triple that time. Upon awakening to the horror that is perpetrated on individual pre-born humans and the exponential societal collateral damage it causes, we "come to ourselves" as did the Prodigal Son of the parable. We begin to see how huge a problem we are facing. Abortion mindset has grown exponentially since the sixties. It seems the whole world embraced what was a very strong taboo in a very short time and killing innocent human life became acceptable. It boggles the mind.

How can we possibly fight such a juggernaut as the culture of death? It is pervasive and if you speak against it, you are declared to be a misogynistic, rightwing bigot. Your point of view is not welcome in the public square.

But once the mind's eye is opened to the truth that no one has the right to take an innocent human life, it no longer matters how big the giant is, we must not be afraid, we must go after the giant. Because the giant is a big lie and Truth is eternal.

So many people have been standing against abortion, witnessing publicly and praying steadfastly for years, reaching out to one soul at a time. Years and years of praying and rarely do we get to see change. It can become daunting. Yet, we continue to pray and to persevere and to find ways to help women who might be considering abortion. It's the kind of thing that works person to person, soul to Sometimes a life is saved, just one soul. But one soul is more valuable than the whole universe.

The closing of the Elizabeth Bagshaw Clinic is, of course, good news. Anytime an abortion mill closes is good news. In fact, I am elated that we are seeing the beginning of the change a'comin.

I believe that our prayer and witnessing, our diligence and faithfulness are having some effect on that huge abortion juggernaut. I see a crack in their armor. It is possible to change hearts and minds throughout the country, one soul at a time. It has happened in the United States. The tide is turning there. Planned Parenthood is in a shambles mostly due to the prayer and witnessing of 40 Days for Life, the March for Life and many other initiatives. Roe vs Wade was overturned in the United States in 2022, and now nearly half (24) of the States have laws

protecting human life. So yes, there is a change a'comin and it only makes sense because the Truth always wins in the end.

Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross are a prayerful, powerful way to focus on Jesus' Passion. There are short prayers at each of the 14 Stations, allowing us to pray and meditate on each specific part of Jesus' final journey. All are invited every Friday during Lent at 6 pm, followed by Mass at 7 pm.

Simon of Cyrene

Jesus carried his heavy cross through the streets of Jerusalem, along the Via Dolorosa. He was already weakened, having stayed up all night and being beaten and scourged in the morning. The burden was extreme, both physically and psychologically. Simon of Cyrene was pressed into carrying the cross for Jesus to offer him relief and to enable him to continue.

Are we a Simon of Cyrene for others? When we become aware of the burden someone else is carrying, what do we do? Do we turn away? Do we tell ourselves they will be okay or that someone else will help them or any other number of excuses? Do we turn toward them and help carry their cross, easing their hardship? It is difficult to carry another's burden. It requires us to give of ourselves and can be mentally draining or time consuming. Yet, as we do so, we will discover the sweetness of the cross in loving our neighbour.


Food for Families 40 Cans for Lent


