





### A Call to Fast and Pray for Peace

Statement by the **Most Rev. William T. McGrattan**, Bishop of Calgary and CCCB President, to the Catholic Faithful in Canada, inviting them to pray and fast for peace.

"Our world is suffering. The wars are growing. All Catholics are invited and encouraged to take up Pope Francis' call to pray and fast for peace. Prayer is a most powerful instrument, capable of healing division, changing hearts, opening minds, and bringing new beginnings to situations which seem impossible. Fasting, in this context, provides a special way by which to join ourselves to the suffering of others, in solidarity with them, as well as to the sufferings endured by Christ during his Passion and Crucifixion. We may think, as we fast, of the many forms of human suffering that are associated with war and all forms of violence, and thereby strengthen the earnestness and concreteness of our prayers. Such steps help to create a society where all people can flourish in the way that God intended. Let us, in this month of the Holy Rosary, ask for Mary's help. Mary, who bears the title Queen of Peace, is a powerful intercessor who, likewise desiring peace among all peoples and nations, brings our prayers and petitions to God and makes them more effective."




