A Brand New Beautiful New Year

It has been a wonderful year at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish.

We have much for which we need to be grateful. During the year of 2025, it had become apparent that, as a parish, **we are a family of families** who care for one another and pitch in at a simple request to help do what needs to be done.

Your generosity, through **Project Advance, the Mustard Seed Project, the Building Fund, Family Fun Day**, and other fundraisers, has allowed us to conduct the renovations of the church basement. The actual construction is virtually done with some finishing work to continue in the new year. I'm hoping it will be fully functional sometime in February or early March. But for now, the room is a big, beautiful, empty space; a blank slate that we will be decorating, filling it with furniture, fixtures and equipment for sure, but really to fill it with joy, laughter, music, and love.

It's been a great year because we have many new parishioners who tell us their families feel so welcome and at home here. It's been a great year because our choir has been working so diligently, practicing and studying new music and liturgies. It's been a great year due to the community building we have done throughout the year: Hosting Les Echos du Pacifique, Family Fun Day, youth outings, Christmas in the Square, and the Simbang Gabi Masses which have drawn over 200 people per night for four nights. It was a wonderful, warm and welcoming scene both in the church and in the Upper St. Anne's Hall after Mass.

We have a firm foundation on which we can build in 2026.

We have been laying the groundwork for moving our parish forward by working with **Divine Renovation Ministry** who provide support to parishes seeking to pursue a missional mindset.

They help transform parishes by developing strong leadership teams and a culture of evangelization. We have already embarked on a journey of **Missional Prayer** which is helping us to better discern, through intentional prayer, how to direct our efforts to engage our parishioners better while reaching out to bring people closer to Christ. We are in the process of building a strong and committed Leadership Team to help the parish move forward efficiently and intentionally to be more holy and welcoming, and therefore more vibrant and thriving.

An example of what that looks like is that, starting on January 6, we will be inviting parishioners to spend an hour to pray the Rosary together and adore our Lord in the Holy Eucharist, intentionally praying for the **mission of our Parish**. This will take place after Mass on Tuesday mornings and from five o'clock until six o'clock on Tuesday evenings. We will be coordinating various activities that will bring us together to fulfill that mission.

About the basement hall, I will be looking for volunteers to help us complete the various aspects of moving in. I will ask you to sign up for one or another activity depending on your interest and skill set. For example, working with sorting books for the library, going through the historical artifacts and helping to decide how best to display them, helping to move furniture, setting up and running a coffee shop and more.

Also, I think it would be fun to have a little contest to come up with a name for the 'hall' other than the word 'basement'. More to come on that.
