This year was a year like no other. Our children in foster care struggled to address their trauma in world that has closed its doors and opened its laptops. Children who struggle in the best of times, are suffering. We are there.

CASA of Southwest Michigan has continued to grow to serve their needs and best interests. Our St. Joseph County (MI) office opened in March 2020. We served 81 children in care with 45 dedicated CASA Volunteers. During the pandemic we trained 24 new CASA Volunteers.

Thank you to our "Friends of CASA" volunteer group who spend countless hours helping to raise funds and increase volunteer recruitment. OUR VOLUNTEERS

Our volunteers are the lifeblood of our work. Each volunteer is thoroughly vetted, trained for over 30 hours and agrees to advocate for a child, meeting weekly in most cases, until that child is in a safe, permanent and loving home or reunified with their parent. Other volunteers assist with data entry, help with outreach, fundraising, and serve on our board.

- CASA Volunteers trained: 24
- CASA Volunteers serving children: 45
- Other volunteers: 15
- Hours contributed by volunteers advocating for children: **2436** (value to community based on IRS rate of \$50/hour: \$121,000)
- Miles driven by CASA Volunteers: **16,047** (value to community: \$9,388.00)
- Child visits by CASA Volunteers: 608
- Percent of Court Hearings Attended by CASA: **100%**
- Average length of time volunteers remain with the program: 26.5 months

Why I volunteer.....




REVENUE AND EXPENSES
