## VAPE TALK

Vape Talk is a presentation that covers the most current and accurate information about youth vaping, discusses the health risks of nicotine use in teens, and shares resources for quitting and refusing vapes. It is endorsed by the South Carolina Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics. It is 45 minutes long but can be tailored for you. It is for middle and high school students, parents, or staff professional development. There is no cost.

## VAPE DISPOSAL KITS

Vape disposal kits are given to middle and high schools throughout South Carolina. A designated administrator or School Resource Officer can store confiscated e-cigarettes/vapes in the provided bin. When the bin is full, simply contact Smokefree SC and we will schedule a collection time. We will take the collected vapes and leave an empty bin. There is no cost.

## PREVENTION & CESSATION GRANTS

Smokefree SC awards grants up to \$5,000 for work done at the local level on tobacco prevention and cessation efforts involving youth and/or coalition support/building.
