According to the results;

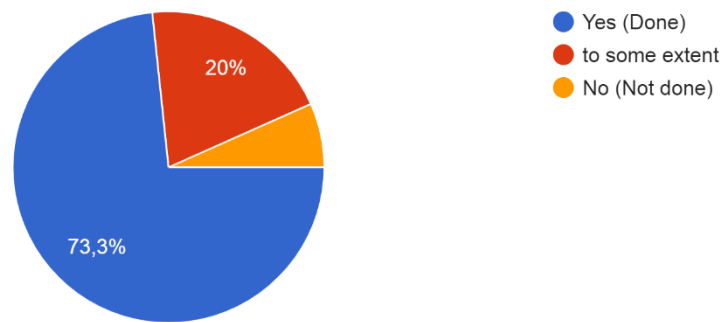
1. 13 online participant took part in the transnational assessment test. Partners organizations/ counties are ranked as four participants: Hoca Ahmed Yesevi Anadolu Lises /Turkey and Escola Secundária de Penafiel/ Portugal.
2. 73.3% of participants think that promotional and dissemination products (project website, project introduction video, brochure, social media groups) are clear and useful enough, 20% of them state that the clearness and satisfaction has been to some extent. 6.7% of the participants think that promotional and dissemination products (project website, project introduction video, brochure, social media groups) are not clear and useful enough.
3. 66.7% of the participants think that the ice-breaking activities were done properly and it was fun, 20% of the participants think that the ice-breaking activities were done properly and it was fun to some extent. 13.3% of the participants think that the ice-breaking activities were not done properly and it was not fun.

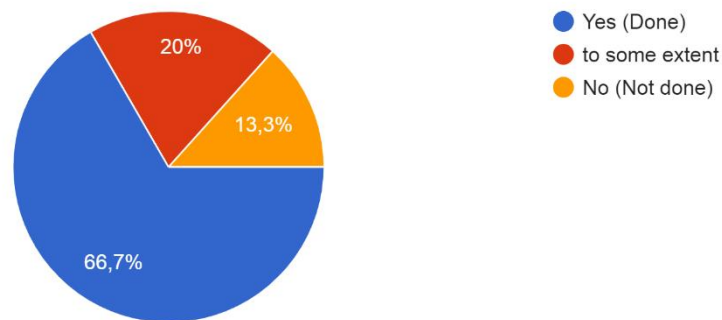

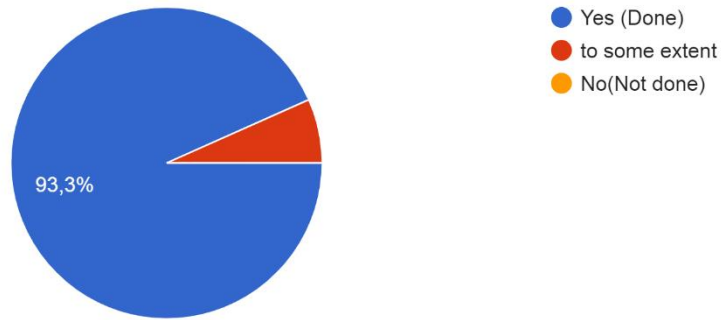

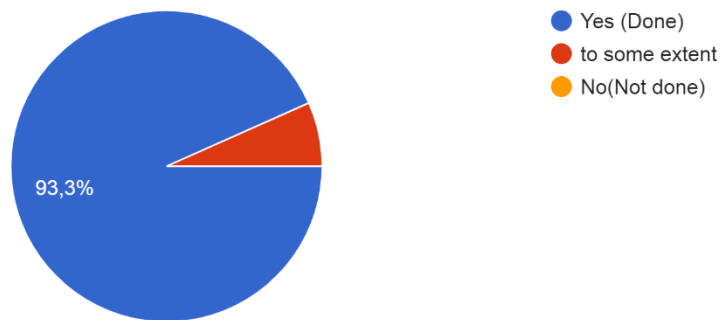

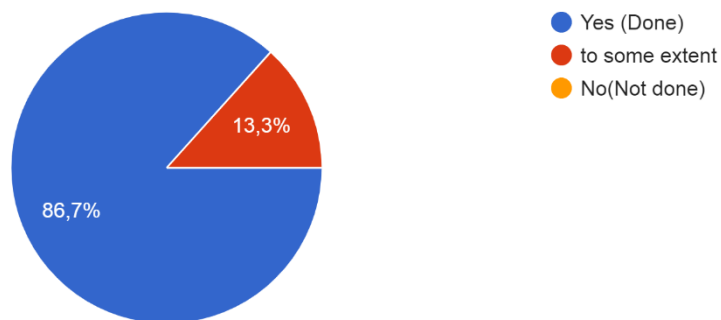

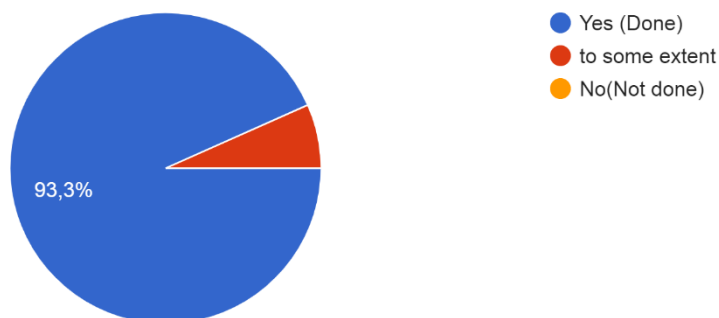

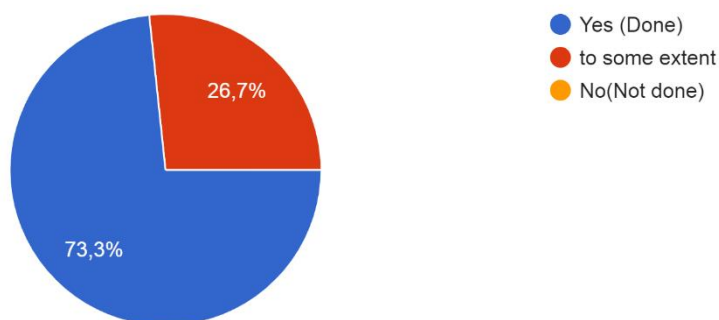

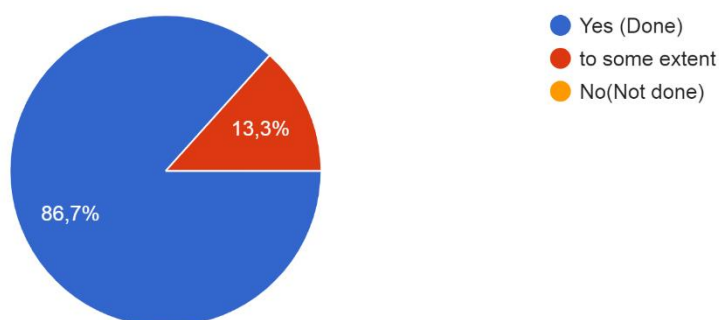
