ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INSIGHTS: Being Part of Many Artists' Journey

The Marshall Regional Arts Council (MRAC) and Texas Sounds International (TSI) are teaming up to bring you even more high-quality music and artistical performances into downtown Marshall, TX.

In August 2021, MRAC began planning its Third Saturday Weekend (TSW) free concert series with the intent to be a bigger contributor to our local Economic Development through Cultural Arts & Tourism. We have successfully accomplished this over this past year by promoting several events that took place during each month's Third Saturday Weekends in downtown Marshall. We did this by presenting and promoting our own TSW artistic performances on public stages while promoting the artistic performances on other privately owned stages located in our downtown. We also extended our promotional activities to include other events happening during TSW like Market on the Square (Harrison County Farmer's Market), events sponsored by The Michelson Museum and the Starr Home, and by promoting local Main Street businesses that provide Dining & Shopping opportunities in downtown Marshall. MRAC worked across many organizations to help create and promote a great experience for Marshall tourists.

When TSI moved its headquarters from Jefferson to Marshall earlier this year, a new cooperative opportunity for providing even more on-stage musical performances was born. In the time since making its move, TSI has actively engaged with MRAC looking for ways that our cooperative efforts would collectively make a bigger economic impact in Marshall than each of our organizations could make independently. Some new opportunities for economic development have grown out of that engagement.

This year, approximately 200 musicians from around the world will come to Marshall for the 2022 Texas Sounds International Country Music Awards. The awards will take place on the Memorial City Hall stage in downtown Marshall October 13-16, 2022. These awards will be taking place at the same time MRAC presents its final Third Saturday Weekend for the year. MRAC and TSI have recognized the mutually beneficial opportunities. We will be working more closely together in the future to help develop our local economy while helping local and international artists develop their music careers.



Post-2022 Country Music Awards Plans

MRAC and TSI will continue making plans promoting Cultural Arts & Tourism for next year's Country Music Awards. With our continued strong support from the City of Marshall for becoming a Certified Texas Music Friendly city, we will have even more opportunities for promoting performances in 2023.







Becoming Texas Music Friendly Certified is critical for our plans to succeed. We will need the support of our community for this certification. Since the Texas Music Office is hosting the **Texas Sounds & Cities Conference** at The Stockyards in Ft. Worth, TX on **November 10 & 11, 2022**, we need to be there as a Certified Texas Music Friendly city. Many Texas Music Friendly Cities are expected to attend. MRAC, TSI, and the Director of Tourism and Economic Development have plans to attend. Besides learning more about how we can bring more tourism using others' successes, MRAC and TSI have begun exploring the possibilities of creating a Lone Star Rising Stars tour to give musicians exposure to new audiences within the family of Texas Music Friendly cities.



The Lone Star Rising Stars tour is currently being envisioned as a 4–6-week music tour that bring our performers into other Certified Texas Music Friendly cities. While still in its infancy, we expect the pathways for being able to even do such a tour would be because of what individual communities want and need to be able to participate in doing the same in our community, as well as the ability for MRAC, TSI, TMO, and other organizations able to work together to get the tour organized and ready to go.



We would continue to employ QR-Code technology to promote the tour as well as the related Texas Historical Monuments & Sites in and around the other Texas Music Friendly cities.



One of the current timeframes being discussed is somewhere from August 2023 through Mid-October 2023. This coincides with the beginning of the 2023 Texas Sounds International Country Music Awards that will take place on our Memorial City Hall stage. Another timeframe being discussed is starting the tour the week or two after the 2023 TSI CMA and through a prearranged agreement promote select artists that TSI and possibly a board would select.



The intent for this tour is to promote our local musicians at the same time we promote Texas Sounds International artists. The tour should expose the artists to new audiences across Texas while promoting to other Texans to come to Marshall for the 2023 Texas Sounds International Country Music Awards.

We're working on building up the Lone Star Rising Stars. We want for our musicians in Marshall and those from other Texas Music Friendly Cities to have paid performance opportunities here in Marshall and across Texas.

With Cultural Arts & Tourism as a foresight for creating this trail of music across Texas, the Marshall Regional Arts Council in cooperation with the City of Marshall and Texas Sounds International, we will be looking for ways we can create opportunities with each of these Certified Texas Music Friendly cities. We want to take our musicians to their cities to experience performing on their stages and provide their musicians with the experiences of performing on our stages.

MRAC & TSI will be teaming up to put together the plans necessary for taking a few of our local and a few of the Texas Sounds International musicians on a performance tour across Texas sometime in Fall 2023. This tour is intended to promote the musicians across Texas and to promote tourism to Marshall, TX with the 2023 Texas Sounds International Country Music Awards.
