- Cannot have been entered in a previous Mini-Monet show
- NO LIMIT ON NUMBER OF SUBMISSIONS, but teachers should select their top choices.
- > All submissions (except sculpture and ceramics) should be matted, ready for hanging
- Selected artwork will be displayed at the reception
- Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Honorable Mention will be given for each grade division
- > OPTIMIST'S CLUB AWARD will be chosen by an Optimist's Club representative.
