Boost Your Child's Reading Skills with These Simple Tips!

Read Aloud Every Day

Make reading together a daily ritual. Even if your child can read on their own, sharing a story aloud fosters bonding and improves comprehension.

Create a Cozy Reading Nook

Designate a special reading corner at home with comfortable cushions and good lighting. Encourage your child to curl up with a book in their cozy space.

Ask Open-Ended Questions

After reading a book, ask questions that encourage critical thinking, like "Why do you think the character made that choice?" This helps improve comprehension.

Set a Reading Example

Children are more likely to read if they see adults enjoying books. Make time for your own reading, and discuss what you're reading with enthusiasm.

Visit the Library Regularly

Explore your local library together. Let your child choose books that interest them, and don't forget to attend library events and storytime sessions.

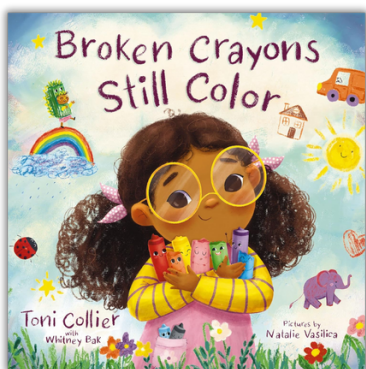
