



Presenter Proposal

Overview

Anclote Pottery offers several clay experiences for your school. Whether a charter, private school or homeschool co-op, we have options to accommodate the needs of your academy. We present in your space, and supply all clay, glazes and tools. Fees include all tools, supplies and firings mentioned in the description. We fire projects in our studio and package and deliver projects once completed.

One Day Experience:

In a one day experience, we will work with groups of 25 or fewer students at a time, for a length of 45- 60 minutes per class. In this time, we will instruct a hand-building project. We will plan age appropriate projects for each grade level, utilizing skills such as rolling coils and slabs. Includes a "clay talk" as students learn where clay is found, how it's been used in history and about the kiln firing process. In the "one day experience" we will stay with your school for the duration of the day, working with up to six classes. We will return fired projects one week later, which can be painted in their regular art class. Option to glaze, see "Two Day Experience" below. **Fee: \$900 per day**

Two Day Experience:

These experiences will be booked one week apart to allow time for firing. In a Two day experience, we will work with the same groups as the first day, glazing projects, which have been through the first firing. This option includes two kiln firings all clay, glazes and tools. **Fee: \$1700 for two days.**

One Week Experience:

This option is best for larger schools, who want clay lessons for all grades and classes. In the one week experience, we will see up to six groups per day with 25 students or less per group. Please see "one day option" above for the description of what we will cover each day. Please note, this option does not include a 2nd day for glazing. **Fee: \$4000 for five days.**

Two Week Experience:

In the "Two Week Experience," we will work with the same groups as we did in the first week, applying glaze to all projects. This option includes two kiln firings, all clay glazes and tools. **Fee: \$7500 for ten days**
