THE MERIT AWARDS COMPETITORS GUIDE

This guide provides the necessary framework for candidates submitting entries for oral presentations and digital posters for the Merit Annual Residents Awards. To ensure your submission aligns with the highest standards of clinical knowledge and academic rigor, it is highly recommended to thoroughly review all official guidelines prior to initiating the application.





MERIT COMPETITOR SUBMISSION STANDARDS

Adherence to the following protocols is required for a successful application:

- **Mandatory Fields:** Every field marked with an asterisk (*) is compulsory and must be finished to submit the form successfully.
- **Data Accuracy:** Residents must ensure that their full name, SCFHS Registration Number, and all contact details are accurate to facilitate the verification process.
- **Compliance:** All submissions must strictly adhere to the established deadlines and technical guidelines provided in the official handbooks.
- **Disqualification Policy:** Any incomplete applications or those missing required metadata will be automatically disqualified from the selection process.

MERIT COMPETITOR APPLICATION DATA

The application form captures critical professional and academic metadata:

- **Personal Information:** Full name (first, middle, last), valid mobile number, and email address.
- **Professional Credentials:** Valid SCFHS Registration Number.
- **Academic Context:** Selection of the specific field of study, current training year, assigned training program, and primary training site.
- **Entry Details:** Selection of the appropriate competition category and the input of the project abstract according to established guidelines.



MERIT AWARDS

ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

To maintain scholarly excellence within the Riyadh Second Health Cluster, all residents participating in the oral presentation or digital poster competitions must adhere to the following abstract standards:

- **Review Process:** All submissions are subjected to a double-blind peer review and must be submitted via the official portal.
- **Ethical Standards:** Content must be original research approved by the program's scientific committee and comply with institutional ethical protocols.
- **Submission Categories:** Residents may submit scholarly work as a Clinical Report, Systematic Review, or Original Research.
- **Technical Specifications:**
 - **Word Count:** Strictly limited to a maximum of 200 words.
 - **Typography:** Must use a standard 10-pitch font in black ink.
 - **Header Format:** The title must be in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS followed by the author's full name, credentials, and affiliation.
 - **Content:** Narrative text only; no tables, figures, or bibliographic references are permitted within the body.
- **Disqualification Criteria:** Abstracts will be rejected for failing to follow formatting guidelines, lack of robust data, or using over-generalized statements regarding future analysis.
