AM Session: 11 – 12, 13 – 14, 15 – 19 swimmers. The warm-up schedule will be posted on the league website after the entries are done. Meet starts TBA. Fly Over Starts will be in effect.

PM Session: 8 & Under, 9 – 10. The warm-up schedule will be posted on the league website after the entries are done. Meet starts TBA.

FACILITIES: Maggs Physical Activities Center, 1101 Camden Ave,
Salisbury, MD 21801

The indoor pool has a 6-lane 25-meter pool with non-turbulent lane lines. SU has starting blocks with a diving depth of 12 feet, Colorado timing system, locker rooms with showers.

- **Only coaches, officials/ timers, marshals, swimmers and clerks of course are permitted on the deck.** Bracelets will be provided to those allowed.
- Everyone else must sit or stand in designated areas.
- Coaches may use the bleachers directly in front of the spectator seating.
- Spectator seating will be on the bleachers.
- ALL spectators MUST use the restroom facilities at the far end of the lobby with designated "Spectator Restroom" sign, locker rooms are for swimmers ONLY.

Spectator Seating: Everyone else must sit or stand in designated areas.

- Coaches, Officials, Timers, Swimmers are permitted on the deck. Passes will be provided to those allowed.
- Coaches may use the bleachers on the far side of the pool
- Swimmers are not allowed in ANY spectator seating areas
- No food or drink is allowed on deck or in the indoor seating areas. Water is permitted on the pool deck only

Marshals: There will be 4 marshals assigned to the meet to make sure the meet runs in an orderly fashion.

Spectator Parking: Please park in lots A & B off of US 13. Limited Handicap parking will be available in lot C. See the facility and parking map at the end of this document.

Coaches and Officials Parking: Please park in lot L off of US 13. See map at end of notice.

Team Staging: The parking lot located on the pool side of the building will be shut down to vehicles for Clerk of Course. Teams will be allowed to set up tents and chairs in the grassy area/quad in front of the pool. Team spots will not be assigned.

Photography: Photography from behind the blocks is PROHIBITED and FLASH photography at the start is PROHIBITED. Only credentialed commercial photographers will be permitted on deck.

Vending: There will be a snack concession table located by the team tent area as well as an Icee food truck provided all day. Additionally, a Salisbury University food stand offering breakfast and lunch will be located at the far end of the building. There will be a t-shirt vendor & Jolyn swim gear vendor onsite all day. T-Shirt Vendor is taking preorders via this site: <https://cre8tee.com/collections/2026-delmarva-swim-association-championships>. Preorders are accepted through July 19th. See Appendix for the 2026 DSA image being used.

Clerk of Course: The initial clerk of course will be located at the door directly in front of the pool. Swimmers will enter the pool area located behind the blocks. **All swimmers regardless of age must report to the clerk of course.** Clerk of Course will run during individual events only; Coaches are responsible for lining up ALL relays. The four teams with the largest number of qualifiers will be required to supply 1 volunteer for CoC at each session.

RULES: Current 2026 DSA rules apply using 2026 USA Swimming stroke and turn rules.

ELIGIBILITY: All swimmers aged 6 to 19 entered must have competed in at least two (2) dual, triangular or sanctioned Invitational meets this season and swam equal or faster than the cut times to compete in Championships. These meets must have been included on the official schedule or have been make-up sessions in which both teams were originally scheduled to participate. **ALL SWIMMERS MUST HAVE A HOLD HARMLESS WAIVER ON FILE (See waiver at end of notice) and each TEAM must PROVIDE PROOF OF INSURANCE to be used as the primary insurance the day of Champs BY THURSDAY JULY 23rd, 2026. These can be scanned and emailed to msauter04@gmail.com.**

VOLUNTEERS: Every team participating in Champs, regardless of number of swimmers, will be required to supply at least 1 (one) volunteer per session to work the meet. The four teams with the largest number of qualifiers will be required to supply 1 volunteer for CoC at each session.

Entries and Fees:

- All entries must be submitted by Sunday at 7 pm July 19, 2026 to the entries director Kara Erskine at kaerskine@gmail.com. These are needed to do warmup, timer assignments and prelim psych sheets.
- ALL entries should be submitted via email (Hy-Tek entry file) along with a file containing a Microsoft word or PDF document of the entries.
- *Please check to be sure the entry times is set up to only use times that were achieved on or after 6/15/2026*
- Entries submitted on paper will not be entered in the meet.
- Individual events are \$7.00. Relays cost \$16.00.
- There is a \$10.00 facility fee per individual swimmer.
- Coaches, please check the DSA website on 7/23/26 evening for the psych sheet.
- Payment options: Venmo @TALBOTSWIMCLUB is our preferred money app. We will accept PayPal as a second option at this [link](#).

DO NOT USE YOUR ENTRY PROGRAM ie TM or SportsEngine, for your entry fees total due, USE the meet fees report by team that will be posted on the Champs page Sunday night at 8 PM. USE THIS AMOUNT ONLY! TSC can then match dues with teams when it arrives in our account.

Here's how to send or request money from the Venmo app:

1. Tap Pay/Request at the bottom of the screen.
2. Use the Search bar to add the person you want to pay or charge, using their name, Venmo username, phone number, or email address; our username is @TALBOTSWIMCLUB
3. Enter an amount and add a note stating your team name and contact info
4. Tap Request/Pay button

Payment must be received by the league treasurer by Tuesday July 21, 2026

CHECK PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS:

- Fees must be paid by a single check payable to Talbot Swim Club, that must be received by the TSC treasurer by Tuesday, July 21, 2026 (Talbot Swim Club, PO Box 3001, Easton, MD 21601).
- All packages sent that require a delivery signature must complete the 'Waiver of Signature.' Please do not require a signature as it will delay delivery.

Individual Entries: All swimmers must swim in their own age group for all individual events based on the May 31 age update.

Relays: Every DSA team is entitled to one "A" relay team per age group. There is no cut time for relays, so any swimmer can participate but swimmers must still meet the two-meet qualifying rule even if they did not make a qualifying time for individuals at Champs. Alternate relay swimmers must be designated on your entries and must not exceed the total number of entries rule.

Relay Swim-up: Any swimmer may be upgraded one (1) age group for relays as long as they do not exceed the maximum entries rule.

Maximum Entries: The maximum entries is the same as the summer dual meets: A

max of 5 events, swimmers are limited to a maximum of three (3) individual scoring events and two (2) relays.

Penalties: Any team that has not paid its League Dues, fines, Championship entry fees, or has outstanding sanctioned Invitational fees for the current year cannot participate in the League Championships. Swimmers, even if they are seeded in Champs, will not swim if any outstanding fees are unpaid.

Next Year's Meet Requests: Teams must make their 2027 meet selections via the DSA web page under "SCHEDULE" by July 24, 2026 in order to be entered in the Championship meet. Go to <http://www.delmarvaswim.org> then "SCHEDULE".

SCORING: There are three divisions: Blue, Red and White. Teams are assigned divisions based on current year's Champs entries. Teams in each division will score points against teams within their division only, using the points system listed below. Divisions will be posted on the Champs tab of the web page.

Scoring for Individual Events: 16, 13, 12, 11, 10, 9, 7, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1

Scoring for Relays: 32, 26, 24, 22, 20, 18, 14, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

AWARDS: Each of the three divisions will receive awards as follows: ages 6 – 18

- Medals 1st thru 3rd
- Ribbons 4th thru 8th (12 and under Only)
- Trophies for each high point age group by team for both boys and girls.
- The top three teams in each division will receive a plaque.

Ages 19 will swim exhibition, will not score, or record or ribbon. Their time will be on the result sheets as EVENT age group 19.

ALL AWARDS MUST BE PICKED UP AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE MEET, AWARDS LEFT WILL NOT BE MAILED AND WILL HAVE TO BE PICKED UP.

GORDON MAYNES AWARD – During the morning session between relays the Scholarships will be awarded, and the Gordon Maynes award will be given.

SENIOR BIOS – For our senior swimmers, their Biographies will be read during one of their swims. All senior Biographies must be submitted to Vance Morris, vance@chesapeake-servicesolutions.com by 7/23/26 in order to be in the program.

SCHOLARSHIP Recipients – Winners will be announced during the AM session breaks.

RESULTS: Real time results will be available the day of the meet via mobile phone by getting the free app for droid based or iphone called "Meet Mobile." Meet Mobile is dependent on Wi-Fi availability. Meet Mobile does have an option to buy just one day of use. Meet results will be on the <http://www.delmarvaswim.org/> web site Saturday pm.

QUALIFYING TIMES: All swimmers in individual events must have met the Championship qualifying times during that year's season at official League meets. This shall include any DSA approved Invitational, except that no "split" times shall be submitted. Times established in time trials or non-league meets shall not be submitted. There will be no unofficial swimmers.

- Assumption of Risk

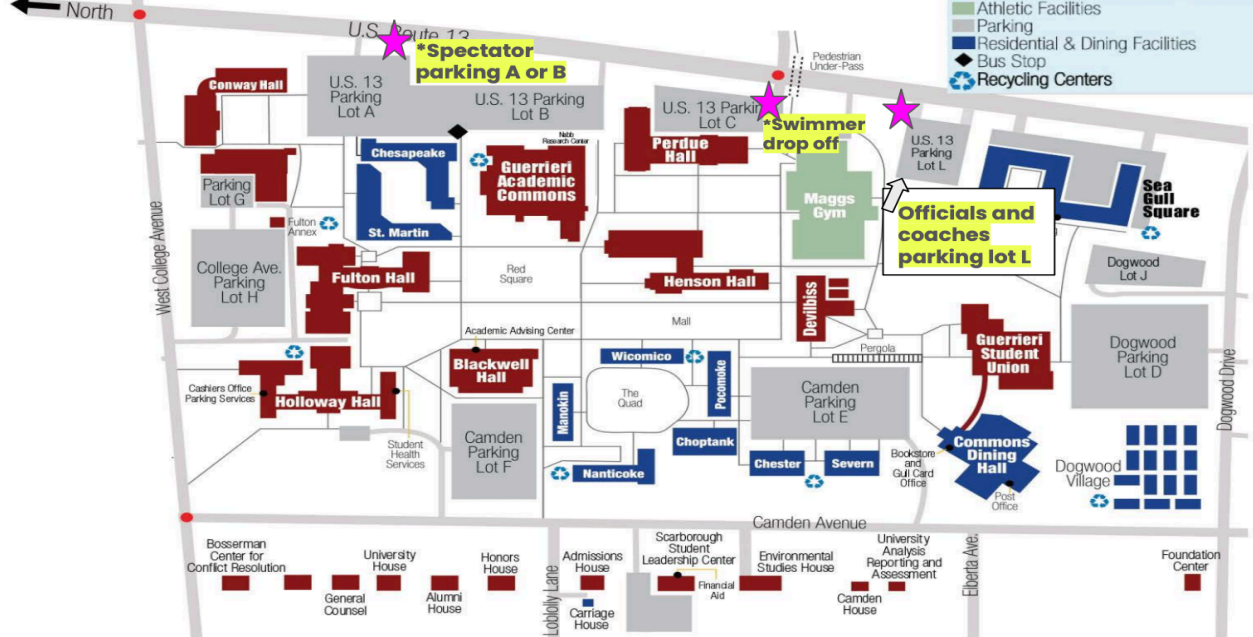

- Waiver, Release, Indemnification & Covenant Not to Sue

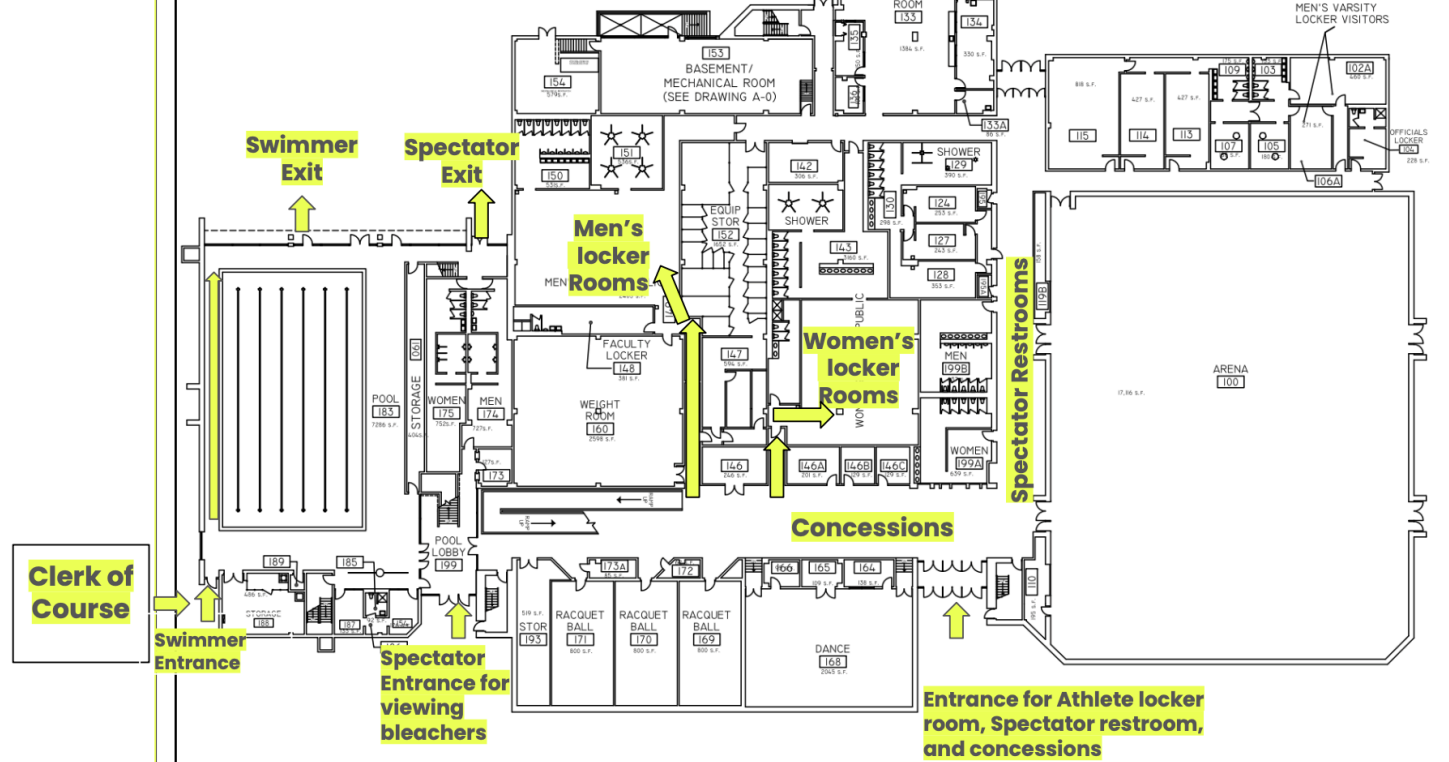
