Madison Park Academy serves 800 students in grades 6-12. Our school campus has been serving the Sobrante Park neighborhood of East Oakland since 1958.

80.7% of our students are Latino, 14.5% African American, 1.4% Pacific Islander, 1.3% Asian, and the remainder white or mixed race. 77.4% of our students speak Spanish at home.



PATHWAYS

MPA's Silver Certified Linked Learning pathways connect core academic course work and pathway-specific skills to real world careers. They help our students stay in school, earn more credits, be more engaged, and gain greater confidence in their life and career skills.

MPA students progress through a rigorous sequence of courses starting with Art Design and Computer Science their freshman year. They then choose either the **Engineering** or **Graphic Design** strand and take a series of three courses that build on one another. Students can deepen their pathway foundations by taking Advanced Art, and AP Computer Science A and B.

SPORTS & PROGRAMS

MPA has a thriving and competitive athletic program for 6-12th grade. Current sports offered include boys football, basketball, soccer, baseball, swimming and track & field; and girls volleyball, tennis, basketball, soccer, softball, swimming and track & field.

MPA offers support programming to impact achievement inside and outside of the classroom. We offer **Restorative Justice** to restore relationships and build community. Our upperclassmen are part of a **mentoring program** to support middle school students, and **math tutors** work closely with teachers to support students.

We have a **full service clinic** on campus offering dental and medical care to students and families. Our **Future Center** staff offers support with every aspect of life after high school, including college applications, financial aid, scholarship assistance, and career planning, and more.





COMMUNITY

MPA offers after school programming for students in grades 6-12. Programs include photography, bike making and riding, cooking and food handling, arts and crafts, Techbridge, gardening, and much more.

BuildOn partners with MPA to provide volunteer opportunities for students, collaborate with teachers, and send students on international trips to build schools in developing countries.
