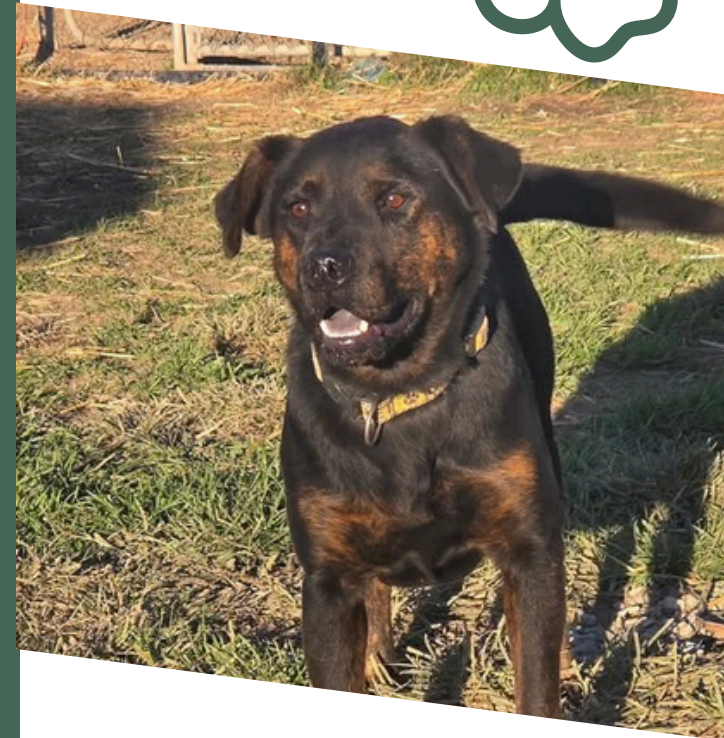

Fostering A Pet

Become a foster pet caretaker and temporarily welcome a pet into your home until they are ready for adoption. Fostering provides them with the invaluable opportunity to live outside of the shelter environment, facilitating socialization and aiding in their rehabilitation.



You, the foster parent, are never under any obligation! You may return your foster pet to us anytime, for any reason.

You may foster a pet once a year or once a week!

We only ask that you give your foster pet food, shelter and love. Medical expenses, if any, are paid by the shelter or through donations.

Adopting A Pet

Our adoption fees help cover the medical care of the animal while he or she waits for a new home, as well as food and transportation costs. These fees help to provide care for the other animals at the shelter who may have medical bills that are much higher than any possible adoption fee. The money also acts as a donation to help support the organization, allowing the group to continue its efforts to rescue and rehome pets.

An adoption fee can end up saving you money!

At PAWs our adoption fees are much less than the cost of vetting the animal.

- Adult Dogs: \$150
- Puppies: \$175
- Dogs Over 5 Years Old: \$100
- Dogs at the Shelter for 1+ Years: \$100
- Adult Cats: \$50
- Kittens: \$75
- Barn Cats: \$10
