- 3) Prepare three recent images and place in a Word document. Include: title if any, medium, dimensions, and year completed. Save as yourname-portfolio in PDF form. Email *Film, video, or new media examples with an accompanying PDF to include title, description, etc.*
- 4) Send ALL material at the same time - no later than April 1 to: wmspencerpierce@gmail.com
- 5) Share your college/art plans with your chosen recommender. Print out the second page of this form and present it to them. They will respond directly to the email above. THIS LETTER CANNOT COME FROM YOUR SCHOOL ART TEACHER, BUT FROM ANOTHER SOURCE FAMILIAR WITH YOU AND YOU WORK.
