3. Principal's report: Erin Dinday, Principal, Miller Creek Middle School

Strong start to school year; staff and parents solution oriented; first homeroom olympics this week; next Friday first grade level assemblies

4. CanDo! report: Jodi Chaban, Executive Director, CanDo!

Newsletter sent out yesterday; Annual Fam Giving campaign; Goal is \$700k; Funding people this year; clubs and after school sports CanDO funds the stipends and a portion of the counselors and a portion of wellness center, stipend for garden staff; fund portion of the technology (50% and then all the schools share in rest).

Board perspective CanDo is a big part of the overall budget and contributes a lot to the district budget;

33% of reaching the goal; good for beginning; 245 families that have donated (19%); at Miller Creek 20% have donated. Schools Rule has 2 funds, a general fund and that gets distributed per district by head count; separate equity fund in Mary J Burke by need. Schools Rule is County wide org and it's split evenly amongst the CA school districts; Miller Creek got about \$36,000.

Grant apps from CanDo; \$5-\$15k approximately; Leah does Grant writing; District doesn't have a grant writer;

Suggested ask is \$750/student

Gave option to opt out of getting direct donation solicitations once they have donated (except for events)
