



#### <u>Please Use Water Wisely</u>

Our community has experienced severe drought conditions and strict water conservation measures in the past. After a few years of good precipitation, the MPMWC Board of Directors has voted to keep our water conservation guidelines at Normal Water Supply Condition. It is important to remember that our PMC aquifer is our sole water source and is not limitless. We encourage all PMC residents to continue conserving water to help sustain this vital resource. Even after an abundant winter, it can take 1.5 to 3 years for our aquifer to fully recharge. Your ongoing efforts in water conservation are greatly appreciated! Above you will find our wells' static levels along with



precipitation history.

### Water Conservation Tips

Please check your irrigation system for leaks and proper operation before setting the timer for the season. Water loss from faulty automatic irrigation systems is most common when homeowners are away and are unable to monitor the ongoing operations of the equipment.

Fix Leaks – A dripping faucet or running toilet can waste thousands of gallons per year.

Limit Shower Time - Keep showers under five minutes and install a low-flow shower head. Stop by our office and pick up a low-flow shower head and toilet water saver kit!

Water Wisely – Water lawns and plants early in the morning or late in the evening to prevent evaporation.

Choose Drought-Resistant Landscaping Native plants require less water and thrive in our climate.

Run Full Loads – Only run dishwashers and washing machines with full loads to maximize water use.
