Why the increase? Inflation along with much needed current and future projects. Since the last increase in 2016 the Consumer Price Index (CPI) has increased 27%.

The Board has done its best to keep the water assessments and rates as low as possible without raising rates for seven years, but with the rising cost of maintaining our aging infrastructure and the need to find new water sources to assure we have water for our shareholders during times of drought, MPMWC Board of Directors and Management believe it is in the community's best interest to no longer postpone the much needed upgrades to our system and go forward with necessary CIP projects.
