

Winterizing Your Home

As winter approaches, homeowners are encouraged to properly winterize their homes to prevent frozen pipes and water system damage. For extended absences, shut off the water at the outside source, call MPMWC staff to shut off your meter. Open faucets to drain lines, adjust the water heater appropriately, add small amounts of food-grade antifreeze to drains and toilets, and insulate any exposed piping. For shorter or periodic visits, maintain interior heat above freezing, shut off the outside water supply, open faucets, and protect exterior pipes with insulation or heat tape.



Important Reminder



Only Mil Potrero Mutual Water Company personnel are authorized to operate the water shut-off valve at the meter. Homeowners must never leave water running at hose bibs or inside the home, as this can cause serious damage, waste water, and violate Company rules. Violations may result in water service being shut off at the meter at the homeowner's expense. 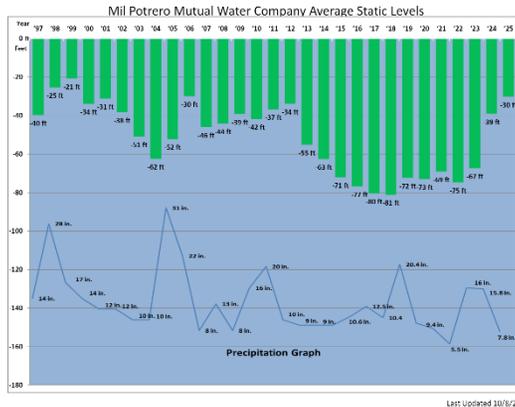
