### **Water Conservation Tips**

MPMWC is in Normal Water Supply Condition. PMC’s aquifer is our only water source. We encourage all residents to continue conserving water. Your efforts are greatly appreciated.

**Check Irrigation** – Inspect for leaks and proper operation before setting timers.

**Fix Leaks** – Drips and running toilets can waste thousands of gallons yearly.

**Shorter Showers** – Keep under 5 minutes; use low-flow fixtures (low flow shower heads are available at our office!).

**Water Smart** – Water early morning or evening to reduce evaporation.

**Drought-Friendly Plants** – Choose native landscaping that uses less water.

**Full Loads Only** – Run dishwashers and washers only when full.
