COMPANY HISTORY

On Monday, November 16th, 2020, Bahamas Lotus (BL) Non-Profit Organization (NPO) #366, was officially granted Non-Profit, status under the Commonwealth of The Bahamas Non-Profit Organizations Act 2019 (No. 25 of 2019 Section 7).

Bahamas Lotus, formerly called Gapseed, was founded on July 5th, 2018. BL began its work by assisting individuals with filling out forms, writing resumes and providing financial support for groceries and educational supplies. Following Hurricane Dorian and during the Covid-19 pandemic, Bahamas Lotus services expanded, to providing support/aid with employment, economic needs, social needs, and self-development.

Bahamas Lotus (BL) is a Nonprofit Organization established to provide assistance, training and resources for the growth and development of individuals and families. BL provides support services and assistance with employment, economic needs, social needs, psychosocial needs, personal enhancement, and family development to individuals living throughout the Commonwealth of The Bahamas and Bahamians living abroad so that Bahamians can live healthier and richer lives. OUR PHILOSOPHY



COMPANY OBJECTIVES

- **TO PROVIDE** basic goods such as: food boxes, school lunches, supplies, clothing and vouchers, etc.
- **TO OFFER** financial skills, training, and strategies to assist individuals and families with budgeting as well as provide help with wage management.
- **TO FACILITATE** application process for individuals and families to access assistance from government, and private entities with funding for utilities, rent, home repairs, childcare, medical, clothing, uniform and burial needs.
- **TO CREATE** and teach developmental training programs for youth and adults.
- **TO SEEK** external funding, Locally and Internationally from various International Organizations to support BL's overall mission/vision.
- **TO PROVIDE** administrative assistance and negotiations for persons seeking emergency and permanent housing as well as to assist families with landlord/tenant issues.
- **TO PROVIDE** emergency relief and assistance to individuals and families of The Bahamas during any catastrophe or natural disaster.
- **TO SEEK** gratis legal assistance for persons needing help with matters regarding child custody, child support, immigration services, violations of the law and victim's rights.
- **TO PROVIDE** training in the areas of parenting, family non-violent communication, child development, infant care, healthy living, self-discipline, problem solving, family conflicts.

TO PREPARE adolescents and young people with the skillset and experience to successfully transitions to adulthood. This is done by empowering them with the knowledge of various support networks and connections available within the community. Bahamas Lotus Centre will offer mentorship resources for young people with disabilities, those who lack traditional family support, live alone, are homeless and who become pregnant.

TO STRENGTHEN individuals and family protective mechanisms, including:

- i. Parental resilience,
- ii. Social connections,
- iii. Economic empowerment,
- iv. Psycho-social supports in times of need,
- v. Knowledge of parenting and child development, and
- vi. Social and emotional competence for children.
