The Luangwa Valley stands as one of Africa's most iconic wildlife sanctuaries. Stretching across the eastern part of Zambia, it protects nearly the entire 350km length of the Luangwa River, a lifeline in this rugged, untamed environment.

The valley transforms dramatically with the seasons, from lush and green early in the year to dry and intense in the later months. This dynamic landscape provides a spectacular backdrop for an authentic safari adventure.

Nyaminga GMA features a rich mosaic of habitats, vast mopane woodlands, dense riverine thickets, and rolling hills, offering ideal conditions for some of Africa's most thrilling big game hunting.

Although a few scattered communities reside within its borders, the majority of the area remains pristine wilderness, where your days are spent fully immersed in Africa's raw beauty.



#### **HUNTING AT NYAMINGA**

Nyaminga GMA is a true haven for dangerous game hunters. Here, the pursuit of legendary free-roaming Cape buffalo, known locally as "dagga boys" or "kakulis," often leads to heart-pounding encounters on foot at close range.

The area also boasts an exceptional leopard population, frequently hunted during daylight hours, along with healthy numbers of lions and elephants.

A highlight of the Luangwa Valley is the striking Cookson's wildebeest, endemic to this region and available in Nyaminga alongside abundant hippo and crocodile.

# **BOOKING TERMS & CONDITIONS**

#### **Quoted Rates**

Daily Rates Include: All meals and beverages in camp, professional hunter fees, daily transport within the hunting area, and national national park ranger presence where required.

Daily Rates Exclude: Trophy fees for hunted animals, CITES permits and ivory registration (if applicable), accommodation and transfers outside the hunting area, staff gratuities, dip and pack services, and trophy shipping.

### **Deposits**

A 50% deposit of the total daily rates is required to secure your booking. The remaining balance must be paid no later than 60 days prior to the start of your safari.

### **Trophy Fees**

Trophy fees must be settled at the conclusion of your safari. Any animal wounded, whether recovered or not, will be charged in full.

#### **Medical & Evacuation Insurance**

All guests are required to carry medical evacuation and health insurance. Artemis Select Hunts can assist in arranging this through trusted global partners.
