i. Property Committee

iii. Stewardship

The campaign begins on Sunday, November 10 and ends with Ingathering Sunday on November 24th. A parish member will speak about the importance of stewardship at each Sunday service. A stewardship letter will be mailed to the parish on October 31st and printed in the Belfry; a follow-up letter will be mailed on November 9.

iv. Defibrillator

We are considering purchasing a defibrillator package for Trinity such as the Phillips HeadStart AED Defibrillator (\$1,275). The wardens would like to find someone with experience in the use of defibrillators to assist in making in this decision.

v. Tri-Town YMCA in Wethersfield is looking for office space to rent for their director. We have a suitable room in the basement. Rose will follow-up.
