PROTOCOLS FOR INDOOR SERVICES

- Masks are optional. Should the need arise, the wearing of masks will be re-instated. (Anyone is encouraged to wear masks as their conscience requires.)
- Be aware of keeping safe distances. There are those who have pre-existing conditions which warrant caution.
- Communicate your needs and concerns as necessary to others in attendance. (e.g. the need for distancing)
- Names will be recorded as a way of communicating the presence of Covid in a service.
- Communion elements may be picked up when entering the sanctuary.
 The empty container may be placed in the cups found in the pew rack.
- An offering plate is on a pedestal near the table with the communion elements.
- Seat yourself, remembering to maintain social distancing. Please move toward the wall at the end of each pew in order that others may also use the pew and still maintain social distancing.
- We request that anyone having Covid-19 or testing positive for Covid-19, who has been in church, immediately contact one of the wardens.
- As applicable these guidelines are standard for meetings in all areas of the buildings.
- A mask is required at all times when in the Parish Office
