Dr. Queen's political career began at 21 when he ran as a Write-In candidate for Waller County Justice of the Peace, Pct.3 & continued with him running for Waller County Commissioner, Pct. 3, in which he successfully won the Primary, but took an unexpected lost in the general election. Understanding that with no struggle there is no progress, Dr. Queen refused to quit and was elected an Honorable City Councilman, Position #5, for the great city of Prairie View, Texas, where he also was the Chairman of the Board of Adjustments & Appeals for their historical city. He was elected in May 2006 within the State of Texas. He has also served as the Mayor Pro Tem 3yrs and completed 4 terms (8yrs) in elected office & 11yrs appointed office in the City of Prairie View.

Dr. Queen is also currently the CEO/Founder of Quality Music Group, the Past National Executive Vice President for F.O.C.G: Sigma Rhomeo Inc., a past Chaplin for the Epsilon Tau Lambda Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., the Past National Chaplain (3 terms) for the Prairie View A&M University National Alumni Association, active member of Lonestar Lodge #85 of District 15a & Lakeshore Lodge #256 of District 7 of the MWPHGLOTX, Past Board Member: PFAW/AAMLC, Co-Founder of Micah Leadership Council: AARA/PFAW, Past Texas State Director: Young Elected Officials Network, Founder: National Black Caucus of the Young Elected Officials Network. Rev. Dr. Queen also served as an Associate Pastor for the world-renowned St. John's United Methodist Church for 14 yrs, and as the COO then Executive Director for Temenos Community Development Corporation & the Bread Of Life, Inc., where he helped to lead the war for spiritual enlightenment and the battles of Hunger, Homelessness, HIV and Community Development. Dr. Queen also is the owner of the Nacho Queen LLC, restaurant & food truck brand, Queen Farms and the Spiritual Boss Cooking/Clothing Brand. He proudly currently serves Grace Hub, Inc. as the Chief Executive Officer and the President of The Board of Directors. Dr. Queen also currently is in his 2nd Term as a Pleasure Island Commissioner in the City Of Port Arthur where he is the Chairman of the Pleasure Island Commission, the Vice President/Chairman of The Political Action Committee for the Port Arthur Branch of the NAACP and the proud Senior Pastor of Love's Front Door International. 
