

GUIDELINES FOR AN ENJOYABLE STAY

Guests and Visitors - Rates are for one RV and one vehicle per site. Any additional vehicles must park in overflow with guest pass obtained from the office. **No parking is permitted in the roadways or unoccupied sites.** Unauthorized vehicles are subject to being towed.

Laundry/Shower Facilities - Located next to the main building (separate entrance). **Open 7:00 am to 8:00 pm** with door code. Door code changes every Wednesday. Building locks at 8:00 pm, reopening at 7:00 am. Last load of laundry must be started and running by 6:30 pm. Minors are to be accompanied by an adult in shower/laundry facilities.

Quiet Hours are from 10:00 pm to 8:00 am. Loud, objectionable noise will not be tolerated. Turn off diesel trucks. Inconsiderate guests will be asked to leave with no refund.

Septic system is a pump lift station. Do not flush or drop anything other than toilet paper and waste in the toilets or in the outside septic tube. NO PAPER TOWELS, GREASE, TRASH, FEMININE PRODUCTS, FLUSHABLE WIPES. Don't allow children to play around the septic tube openings.

ATVs - ATVs are illegal on all Homer Spit beaches and roadways, per city ordinance.

Fires & Barbecues - Fires are ONLY allowed in sites with fire rings or self-contained stove (i.e., Solo Stove). Open fires are NOT permitted on the ground in other site types. Keep hibachis on the GRAVEL only, not on picnic tables or grass. Guests are welcome to use our gas barbecue grills anytime they are available. Located by office building.

Pets - Leashed pets are welcome anywhere in the park or on the beach. Do not leave your animal tethered outside or unattended at any time, and clean up after your pet. Dog Walking Available by Request. Pick up forms at office.

Gift Shop - The gift shop is open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. Please ask the front desk clerk for assistance.

Coffee Shop - The coffee shop seating area is available from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. This area is open to all guests for eating, card playing and visiting.

Within the Sites - Treat your site with care and respect. Report any damages to the office. The fishing lagoon has fish cleaning facilities located near the public restrooms. **Do not clean fish outside in your site. The water from fish and boat cleaning on the gravel is unsanitary. No septic hoses may be left on the ground unhooked up to the RV, Sewage waste may spill.**
