Preface

A commonly used word Shell includes thousand of species in phylum Mollusca. Word derived from the Greek term Mollos. Soft-bodied molluscs are one of the most ancient/Oldest (more than 500 million years) groups of animals on earth after insect (Phylum Arthropoda). 2nd Largest Phylum divided into 8 taxonomic classes. And it's largest marine phylum. Which are highly diverse with Approx 85000 extant species not just in size and anatomical structure, but also in behaviour and living habitat. They have well colonized wide range of habitats in Marine, fresh-water and Land.

Material

Each shell which pick up from beach are made of same stuff Calcium Carbonate (CaCO_3), it's also known as Calcite or aragonite. Basically Calcite or aragonite both have same chemical composition, difference is only in molecular structure. Many shells used both compositions together. In mother of Pearl or Mussel shell outside growing edges form with help of calcite whereas inner side thickens growth is because of aragonite layers which also known as shining layer of nacre.

Size & Life Span

With a growth of molluscs body other protective shell also need to be bigger, so to achieve that, molluscs grow shell with layer to layer & this growth may be on outer surface as well as on inner part which increments in width, length or thickness. As lots difference in species of molluscs, there is a big variation in shapes, size and colour of shell. Which also dependent on habitat and environmental condition, like temperature or salinity. A cold water species of edible clam *Arctica Islandica* from North Atlantic Ocean have sizes 50 mm but it's recorded life of 507 years just because of slow life style. Where warm tropical species of Giant Clams (Genus : *Tridacna*) have recorded size of 1,368.7 mm and have average 100 year life span.

Mollusc size range from very tiny to impressive giant. Class Gastropod species *Syrinx aruanus* commonly known as Australian Trumpet have recorded size of 772.0 mm with Avg. 18 kg weight. Other side a tiniest mollusc *Acmella nana* live in limestone cliffs in Malaysian Borneo have size of 0.7 mm.

In class Bivalve species *Kuphus polythalamia*, *Tridacna gigas* and *Pinna nobilis* have maximum recorded shell sizes of 1532 mm, 1368.7 mm and 970.0 mm respectively. Among class cephalopods Antarctic squid or giant cranch squid is believed to be the largest squid species in terms of mass, can grow up to 10 mtr. And largest chiton *Cryptochiton stelleri* known as Gumboot chiton can grow up to 360 mm with average weight 2 kg.

Formation

A control mechanism behind shell formation is still mystery and not known properly. But what we know is, shell made with help of molluscs organ called "Mantle". and process of shell creation known as biomineralisation. Mantle can poke out of shell and work as printer nozzle which makes pigment and layer different composition of essential material fluid. This fluid contains calcium(Ca^{2+}), Carbon(C),and Oxygen(O). Whereas carbon and oxygen work as carbonate (CO_3^{2-}). First layer of conchiolin (Protein + chitin) lay by Molluscs. Where chitin is one type of polymer which found in many animals body. After that molluscs make a layer of calcium carbonate in form of Calcite or aragonite.

May this question raise in everyone mind. Shell is only outer protective cover to serve fragile inhabitants, So why shell have patterns ?. Is it to attract partner or to be camouflage?. But in that case many bivalve species spent entire life in hidden under rock or sand than also they have different pattern. One study also says that molluscs use different pattern shape to help rebuild shells while they damage because of attack of predators or by stormy wave.

Colour

Seashell available for every spectrum of the rainbow, from a light red to deep violet, also in white, black, brown and grey. Once again colour based on environment For example, warm waters species tend to be more colourful than those from cold areas. This might have to do with their diet. Colour are caused by pigments incorporated into calcium carbonate in form of strips, dots or spirals. But many secrete yet not know how the colours get spread around to creating brilliant patterns.

Habitats

Gastropods have a worldwide distribution, from Arctic and Antarctic to tropical zone. They adapted to almost every kind of existence on earth and having colonized nearly every available medium. Some of familiar and better-known gastropods are live on land known as snails and slugs. Some live in fresh water, but maximum live in a marine environment. Some familiar Habitats are introduced with photographs elsewhere in book.

In habitats with acidic soils on land, where not enough calcium carbonate available to build solid shell, there also various species of slugs and snails with thin, translucent shells occur, where composed of the protein conchiolin used as shell material.

molluscs species *Xerocrassa seetzeni* and *Sphincterochila boissieri* have adopted In desert condition. Other side *Chrysomallon squamiferum* commonly known as the scaly-foot gastropod have adopted extreme tough condition near deepwater hydrothermal vents at depth of 2900 mtr with unique constructed shell consists of iron sulphides.

Shell Collecting Tips

Why Shells Collecting ?

“Shell”, a external skeleton of a soft-bodied animal known as a mollusc. Since ancient times they always delight all of us from their bright colors, curious shapes and amazing patterns. This make them among the most fascinating creations of nature. Such characteristics make shells a satisfying subject to study and to collect. Because of point as mention below anybody can easily attract towards this hobby.

- 1) Easy to Self Collect
- 2) Easy to storage
- 3) No need for special Chemical preservation
- 4) Large range of spices availability
- 5) Life Long Collection

How To Start Shell Collecting ?

- 1) Self Pickup :- you collecting/pickup them up from natural habitats i.e. sea, land & Fresh water, it's most enjoyable & adventure activity & may also be cheapest.
- 2) Exchange :- by exchange with other hobbyist/collectors, before this U must have to make personal collection for exchange.
- 3) Purchase :- purchasing different verities from dealers. But some time it's become costliest way.

Collecting Seashell on seashore is most enjoyable & instructive alternative for the conservation-conscious collector it is the ideal way because it does not interfere with the natural habitat. we find lying on the beach, especially those wrenched from offshore habitats by storms, are often well preserved and very suitable for a collection. With a minimum of effort it is possible to make a large and varied exhibition of such "beached" shells. Other ways to collect shells, such as picking them off rocks or diving to collect them from the depths of the ocean, ultimately involve removing the animals within, but it may consider objectionable. However, these alternative methods bring you into closer contact with the living occupants of shells with the real habitats.

But it always advisable to never collect live shells from their real habitats because after some more effort dead Shells can Easily found in same verities without effecting nature. And always go with Species verity not with quantity of spices. Before you collect any live specimens, always make sure you are not disobeying local conservation regulations. At some places you may need a special permit to collect or purchase some species.



Thing Required

Thing Shown in image can be used for collection & safe storage



- 1 - Hand gloves - safety purpose
- 2 - Bleaching powder, shop solution, Acid used in toilet cleaning for cleaning purpose
- 3 - Toothbrush - to remove Sand/ mud
- 4 - Tweezers - to extract shell from rock crevices
- 5 - Paint brush - to normal dust cleaning of shell
- 6 - Mineral Oil, Baby Oil or Varnish for polishing purpose
- 7 - Note & pen - to make related notifications

- 8 - Magnifying glass - for visual inspection
- 9 - Scale - shell dimensions measurement purpose.
- 10 - Different size plastic/Glass container box/Bucket & Zipper Bag - for specimen Storage/collection purpose.
- 11 - Sticker/Labels - to marking on shell or container

- ⇒ For Marine shells, Need to study local tide table for beach, which you plan to visit, now it's easily available on play store mobile application. By this choose safe & best visit time, When tide is low so you'll be able to find shells that may be covered in water during high tide & more area of beach can exposed, so low tide is a best time for a shell collecting. Different varieties of shells often wash ashore during big storms, so you can find some gems if you head to the beach at right after bad weather.
- ⇒ Fresh water shells, you can search near by pond & river area
- ⇒ Land shells can be found in Garden and Forest area, best time is monsoon to inspect land snails live,

Cleaning & Polishing of shells

There many methods cleaning a shell, which are easily available on google, One of them link <https://www.wikihow.com/Clean-and-Polish-Seashell>

And after Cleaning for Polishing a shell a Baby Oil, or any mineral oil can be used. Where as for permanent signing Varnish Spray can also be useful.

Short Listing & Identifications

655 species/verities are illustrated in this book from which you can identify. Or in second preference many different books as also mention elsewhere this book. At Starting it's advisable to go only up to Family or Genus level Short listing, once you get more familiar with it, than you can go further for Species level Identification. After identification make one register for record. and make marking or numbering on shell / container with unique identification and easy record keeping. Always crosscheck your specie with more than two reference image to get correct identification. As many Synonymised names used for each species, that's why it required to check correct/latest accepted Scientific name. Which can be checked on website <http://www.marinespecies.org/>

Safe & decorative storage


For normal storage purpose multi-section plastic boxes, cartons can be used, which can be easily available in market. But for higher stage storage you may required drawer type table, Glass cupboard or Rack. Protect from direct sun light and humidity.

For decorative Storage any idea can be applied with respect to size, type of shell by using any items that available like empty glass bottles, Jar molds, Glass/ plastic Jar, Glass showcase box etc. Also shell can be stick or hand with clip on wooden board in desired shape as shown below
