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This is presented annually at the August K-9 Obedience trials
to the dog and handler team who has achieved the highest,
High in Trial score from the Regular Obedience classes
over the two weekend days.

In the event of a tie, a run-off will determine the winner.
A dog must be owner handled and must compete both days.

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The recipient of this award will receive an individual plaque with an engraved plate
inscribed with their name, the dog's name
and score, an 8 x 10 photograph, and a \$25 cash award.

The name of each award recipient will also be inscribed
on the coordinating memorial plaque,
on permanent display in our clubhouse.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Trial Secretary's address, 9 p.m., Wednesday, July 27, 2022, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Exhibitors please note: A RECORDING FEE and event fee will be required for each dog and are included in the entry fees as mentioned herein. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the fees are to be collected on the first entry only at each Obedience Trial. Fees are collected on each Rally entry. All fees are included in the entry fees listed. Rally and Obedience are each separate trials. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

MAKE CHECKS and money orders payable to K-9 OTC, Inc. (Returned check fee is \$20.00 and does not constitute a valid entry.) Write the class entered on the face of the check. No third-party checks accepted.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS. Photocopies of front and back will only be accepted if legible. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT SIGNATURE, FEES, OR BACK OF ENTRY AGREEMENT. Illegible entries will not be accepted.**

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. Bitches who come in season after the closing date will have the entry fee less \$5.00 refunded upon written certification by a licensed Veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial.

NOTIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE TRIAL SECRETARY BEFORE 8:00 A.M. (CDST) FRIDAY, August 12, 2022.

IF, BECAUSE OF RIOTS, CIVIL DISTURBANCES, OR OTHER ACTS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE MANAGEMANET, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO OPEN OR TO COMPLETE THIS SHOW, NO REFUND OF ENTRY FEE WILL BE MADE.

SHOW HOURS are 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (CDST). Dogs are not required to be at the show until scheduled time of judging. Judges will NOT wait for dogs. Dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed at the trial. Exhibitors must remain for presentation if eligible for special prizes or they will be forfeited.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH except when being judged. The owner/handler of each dog is solely responsible for being ready ringside when its class is being judged.

ENTRIES MAY BE DECLINED by K-9 Obedience Training Club of Menomonee Falls, Inc. for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other causes and no one shall have any claim or recourse against K-9 OTC or any official thereof.

THE SHOW GIVING CLUB assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by the exhibitors, handlers, or to any dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of parents or guardians.

Please exercise and relieve your dog(s) in the designated potty areas west of the driveway. Pick up and dispose of waste in the receptacles provided. Thank you.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

OUT OF STATE EXHIBITORS: Exhibitors from outside Wisconsin must comply with the following regulations: Wisconsin Department of Agriculture Rule enacted in 1954: No person shall import a dog over 6 months of age into the state unless it is accompanied by an interstate health certificate including thereon a vaccination for rabies, etc. Such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 12 months prior to entry. Provided that when chick embryo vaccination is used, such vaccination shall be conducted not more than 36 months prior to entry. An interstate Health Certificate shall be executed by a Veterinarian of the State of origin, showing animals identified thereon have been inspected and no infectious disease disclosed, and to include a rabies report.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the show or obedience trial and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
