Recipe for the month:

Sausage, Spinach & White Bean Soup

- 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- 1 (12.8 oz.) package sausage, thinly sliced
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 onion, diced
- 3 carrots, peeled & diced
- 2 celery ribs, diced
- 2 (15 oz.) cans white beans, drained & rinsed
- 1/2 tsp. dried oregano
- 2 bay leaves
- 4 cups chicken broth
- Salt & pepper
- 3 cups baby spinach
- 1/2 cup shaved Parmesan

Lightly brown sausage and then add it to the slow cooker with the garlic, onion, carrots, celery, beans, oregano, and bay leaves. Season with salt and pepper to taste. Stir in the chicken broth and 2 cups of water. Cook on low heat for 7-8 hours or high heat for 3-4 hours. Stir in the spinach until it is wilted and serve topped with Parmesan.
