<u>Legislative Update-Teresa Rosenberger, Lobbyist,</u> <u>Bernstein Shur</u>

Next week is crossover, when all the bills in one body that are moving forward cross to the other body. The House and Senate will both meet on Thursday the 31st to vote on all remaining bills in their Chambers. If it does not pass or is not voted on, it does not move forward.

Now that we are almost half way through this session, the House is already thinking about legislation for 2023. The House has set their filing deadlines for 2023 legislation.

September 6 -16 filing period for incumbents running for re-election to file LSRs for 2023 with complete information

November 9-22 filing period for those who won the election
