Maintain and modify your motorcycle with the included 24-inch loading ramp, hand-operated tire bead breaker for quick tire changes, wheel balancer, a 1,100-pound motorcycle jack, a stool with built-in tray, and a whole load of accessories that will come in handy when you get your or your buddy's bike on the table.

#### Pilot Direct Air Jacket V3

This next-generation Direct Air mesh jacket delivers plenty of effective and new rider-oriented features.

The new V3 features a tough, 210D Dense Interlink Mesh (DIM) exterior that passes air freely, yet this dense, overlocking weave pattern provides extraordinary durability and abrasion resistance. All key impact zones are double-layered and triplestitched for increased durability. The V3 incorporates next-generation armor too: CE-rated CORE Force Impact Armor. This new, composite armor employs recent advances in polymer compound technology in order to remain flexible and forgiving when worn, for excellent rider comfort. But upon impact, this next-gen armor stiffens to absorb and disperse impact energy. Net result: a more comfortable jacket, with a higher level of safety.

Riding in summertime doesn't excuse you from rain showers, so the Direct Air V3 incorporates an allnew zip-out removable REISSA waterproof liner that also effectively blocks out wind. REISSA is a lightweight, breathable material that keeps water out while allowing warm, moist air to escape from within the jacket. That adds up to loads of versatility: You can be cool in the sun, warm as the evening temps drop, and dry in the rain.

There's also a host of other motorcycling-oriented details that make the Direct Air V3 especially effective out on the open road. Some more notable features include: the neck has been lowered 1 cm for a more comfortable fit; a handy wrist pocket allows for quick access to small items; a new, larger cell phone pocket accepts the newer, oversized phones; there's a pass-through port for the cord of a heated vest; and the V3 is ready to accept a Pilot CORE Chest Protector thanks to a strip of female Velcro sewn to the inner wind flap of the jacket.

Pilot offers the V3 in six different color options, with sizes spanning Small to 3XL. Perhaps best of all, MSRP for the new Direct Air V3 lists at only \$160—eminently affordable, and vastly safer than taking to the road with only a T-shirt between you and the elements.

#### **COASTAL CRUISING**



The trip plan is pretty simple: Catch Pacific Coast Highway at the top of Oregon and head south about 1,300 miles, keeping the ocean immediately to our right, until you hit LA.

West Coast Tour Essentials Riding Highway 1 and Pacific Coast Highway—whether all or part of it—should be an entry on any motorcyclist's bucket list. #### **Road Notes**






