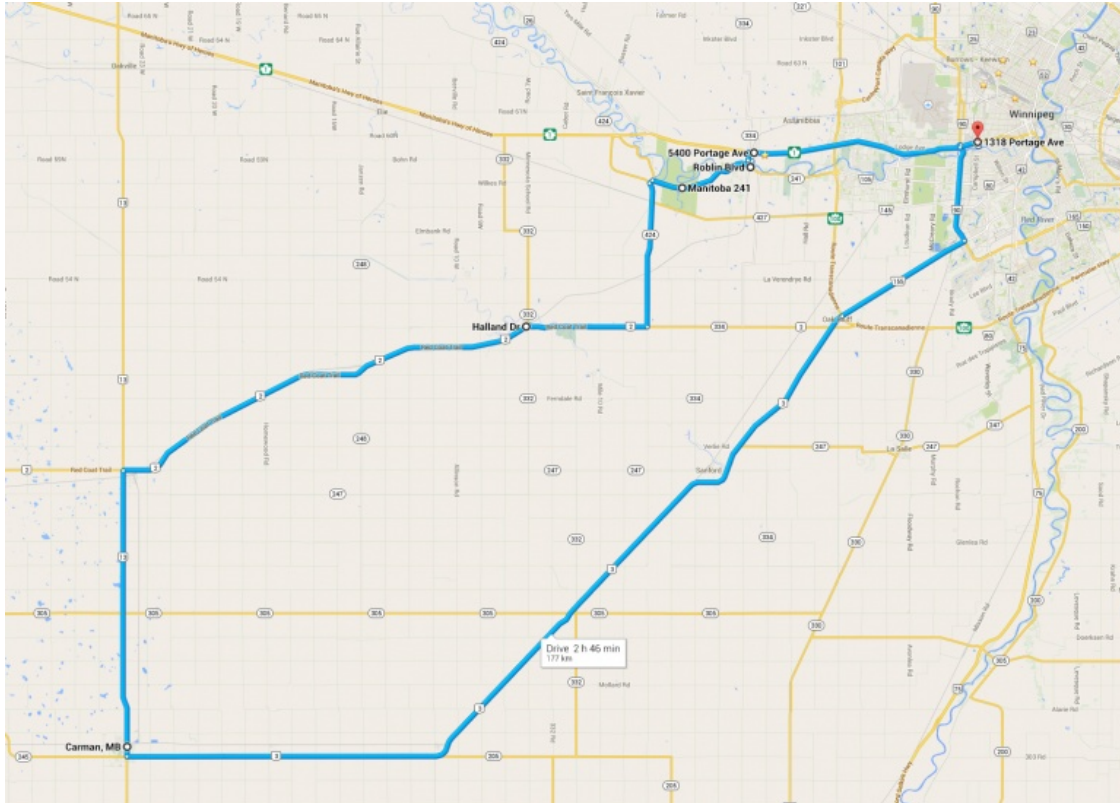

## SOUTHERN SCOOT FOR A SCOOP

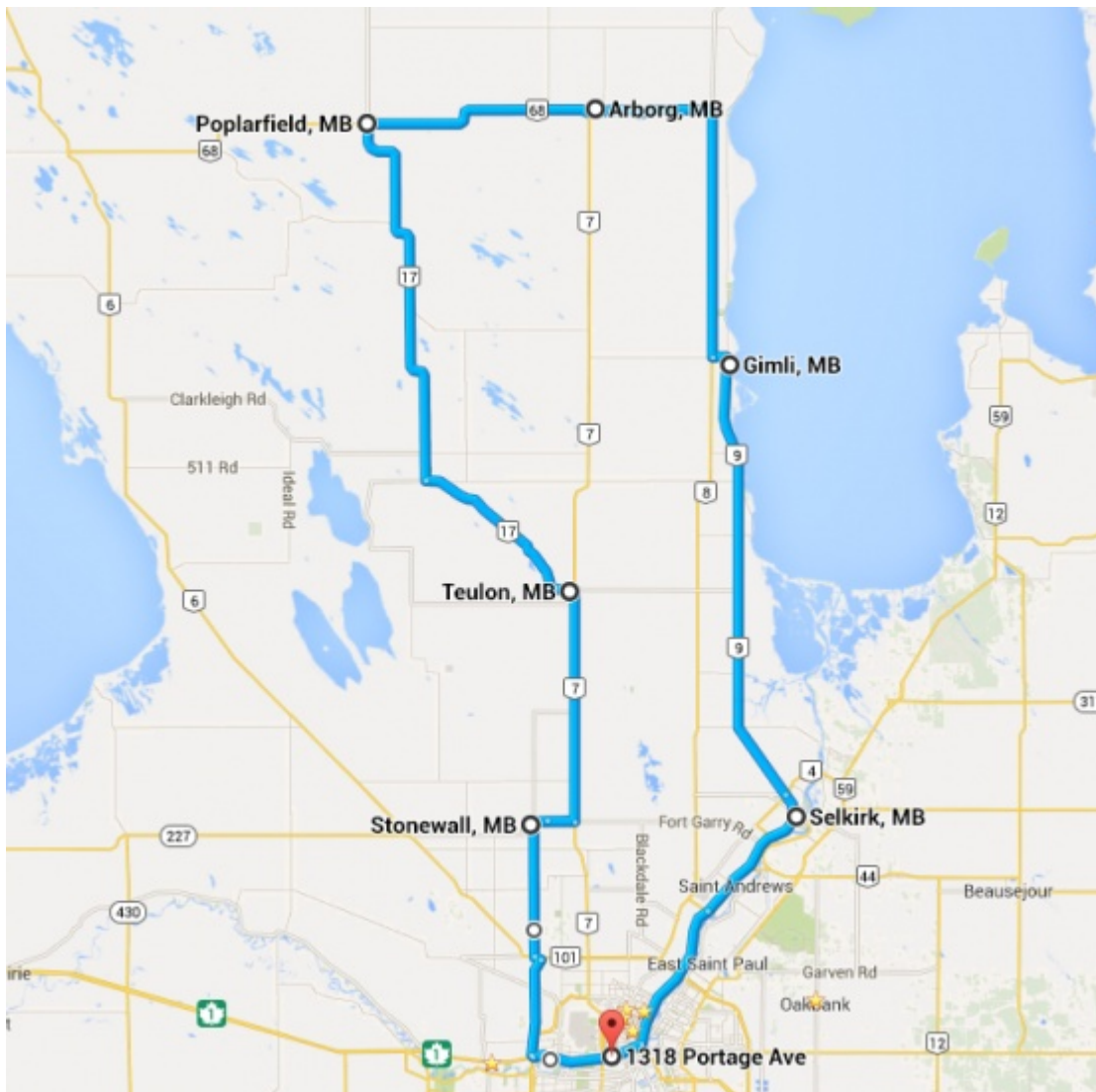

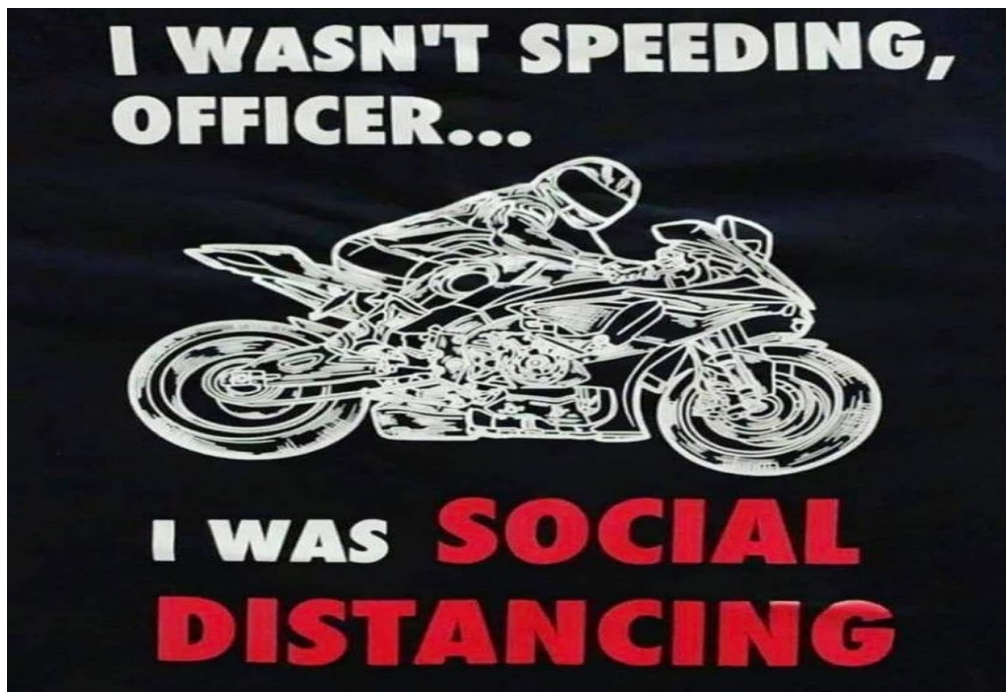
#### BETOOLL Tire Repair Kit \$16.89

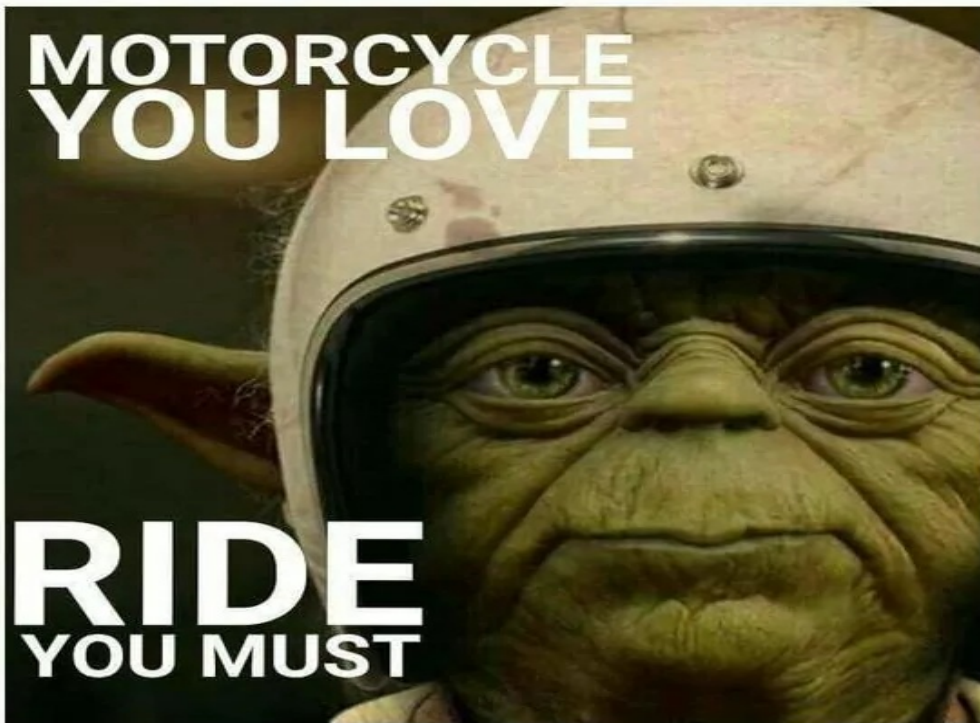

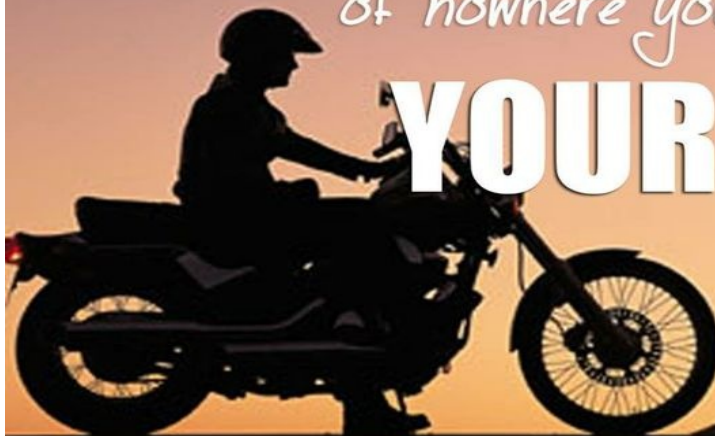
