






### **WINTER RIDE ANYONE?**

### **SCENIC ROUTE FROM SAN DIEGO**


Is there any scenic countryside left for motorcyclists in the urban sprawl of Southern California? Actually there is, and it's surprisingly close to the densely populated areas of San Diego County and amazingly diverse in climate, altitude and scenery. So pack up your bike in a trailer or fly down and rent a bike to take this wonderful getaway winter ride.

The road is nearly an elevator, taking you through 21 switchbacks up to the 5,200-foot summit —a 2,500-foot climb in less than seven miles. The view from the top is stunning. On a clear morning, you can easily see west to the Pacific Ocean and south to the Mexican border.

The scenery changes and gives quite a variety to enjoy.



Only 45 minutes from the summit of Palomar Mountain, and the scene has changed from pines to cacti as you skirt the border of the Anza-Borrego Desert State Park.



Don't look down! It's a nearly 2,500-foot drop from the summit of South Grade Road to the valley below.



You can't say they didn't warn you. There is some serious climbing and twisting ahead to reach the Palomar Mountain summit.



A clear day on the mountain. The marine fog layer from the Pacific encompasses the valley to the west and the hills of Mexico can be seen to the south.



There's 2,000 feet to climb back up from the desert floor on the wonderfully twisty and smooth Banner Grade.

# New Gear: Joe Rocket's Crossfire Jacket




Constructed from Invista Cordura material, Joe Rocket's Crossfire jacket is both waterproof and breathable. A removable full-sleeve thermal liner insulates the rider when the temperatures dip, while sleeve, chest, and back vents circulate air when the mercury rises. In addition to the abrasion-resistant outer shell, the Crossfire protects with shoulder, elbow, and back armor. Adjustment straps and fasteners allow users to tailor the fit, while memory foam padding at the lower back adds an extra layer of comfort. For \$249.99, Joe Rocket offers the Crossfire in five colors and sizes S-5XL.
