WINTER RIDE ANYONE 2?

This all-paved Pacific Coast Highway motorcycle tour is a dream motorcycle trip along the West Coast of the United States. Start in Long Beach, California (or San Francisco) and ride north, hugging the Pacific Coast all the way to the Golden Gate Bridge in San Francisco. Enjoy a day near San Francisco, in Tiburon, where you can explore the city on your own or explore the area on two wheels. Continue on Highway 1 all the way to Oregon. This ride features the epic coastal scenery of California and Oregon: curves, Redwood forests and great scenery are the order of the day.

DAY 1 - San Francisco

Explore San Francisco on your own, experience the San Francisco Bay area before we collect ourselves and head further north. Stay in Tiburon, CA. Unload your bike or rent one.

DAY 2 - San Francisco to Mendocino, CA (150miles)

Enjoy the iconic Pacific Coast Highway 1. Great views await as you travel along the Pacific Coast. Stay in Mendocino, California.

DAY 3 - Mendocino, CA to Eureka, CA (150 miles)

Today is a day for the Redwoods! Ride through the Avenue of the Giants full of old growth Redwood Trees. Get ready for natural splendor. Stay in Eureka, California.

DAY 4 - Eureka, CA to Florence, OR (265 miles)

View the historic Umpqua Lighthouse and ride through Redwood National Park on your way north. Moto-travel through the old growth forests of Oregon and the Oregon Sand Dunes. Stay in Florence, Oregon.






