Amy's Update of São Paulo

"God is so good, and the team is amazing! All are lovers of God and hungry for Him.

I had a word of knowledge [about a] broken/injured right ankle from a motorcycle accident. The guy came up and was healed. A kidney stone was removed...we have not seen much healing, however there is an overflowing abundance of His Spirit.

Almost everyone that comes up and is prayed for goes down in the Spirit. The leader says he's never seen God move this way in Brazil. The people are so hungry. Today, [in] street ministry, a transgender prostitute that I ministered to came to the Lord. Then the Lord spoke to me through him! We prayed for many people on the streets today. God is so good! The team is in unity and love. Almost half the team are pastors.

Also, I had the honor of praying for and helping the pastor's wife release some deep emotional and spiritual wounds at the church where we have been ministering. Everyone is believing for a big move of God in the next churches."
