Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope this letter finds everyone in good health. St. Mary's Academy Charter School would like to inform parents/guardians of the following changes in the daily school schedule beginning on Monday, February 7, 2022.

The schedule has changed to accommodate our new TCLAS (Texas COVID Learning Acceleration Support) after school program. The after school program will be in session from 3:30 pm - 6:30 pm. It will gear towards providing students the opportunity to receive academic and enrichment activities in Math and Reading. The program is necessary for our students to acquire tutorials for learning loss due to COVID-19 school closures or absences. Homeroom teachers will be communicating with parents on tutorial sessions, and a letter will be sent home on Wednesday, February 3. They are adapting to this new program and to schedule changes, so please keep an eye out for more communication regarding TCLAS.

Once again, beginning on Monday, February 7, students will be released from school 30 minutes earlier each day than the current schedule. Note that morning times and school starting times will not change. School hours will now be from 8:00 am -3:30 pm. Students may arrive for early care at 7:00 am. Students may also be picked up during the program; however, we encourage parents to please adhere to keeping tutorial time consistent.
