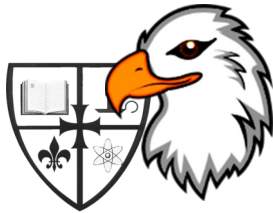

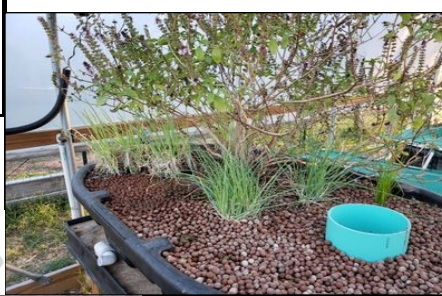


3rd Grade
