

Dying to Sin Romans 6:1-11

A person saved by grace has <u>victory</u> over sin's power through Jesus Christ.

Lessons for Us

Christians are not to <u>willfully</u> live in <u>sin</u> and <u>ignore</u> holy living. (vv.1-2; 1 Pet. 1:13-16)

Christians have <u>died</u> <u>to</u> <u>sin</u> as the master over our lives. (v.2; 1 John 3:9; Col. 3:1-9)

God truly wants us \underline{to} \underline{know} and understand this changed life. (vv. 3,6,9)

o God makes a person new at salvation. God justifies and sanctifies us. (Phill. 1:6)

A saved person is <u>identified</u> and <u>united</u> with Christ. (vv. 3-4; 1 Cor. 10:2, 6:15,17)

o Christians are <u>dead</u> to sin's mastery, our unsaved life is buried, and we are now a <u>new</u> <u>person</u> to grow in Christ.

Saved people go forward in a new, changed life. (vv. 5-7)

o We are now <u>united</u> with Him. We view sin as something "saved from" and something we now cannot "hold to".

o We rest in <u>His</u> <u>power</u>. We are no longer under the penalty or the power of sin.

o Our personal behavior is <u>different</u>. We repent, are broken about sin, and turn away from sin.

o We are set free from sin for eternity, but God also wants us <u>walk</u> <u>freely</u> each day in victory over sin.

Our nature is <u>not</u> <u>controlled</u> by sin. (vv. 8-10)

o The eternal condemnation of sin and death are **defeated**. Rest in that power!!

You are dead to sin for eternity, dying to sinful acts each day, and are to <u>live in Christ</u> in victory each day. (vv.10-11)

My Response

Each person must <u>examine</u> themselves and see if there is a changed life in Christ. (2 Cor. 13:5)

We must not accept mediocrity, realize our life in him, and reject sin.

We must completely <u>rest in Him</u> and <u>rejoice</u> in the victory we have in Christ.
