Dear Mr. Greenhawk:

On behalf of the Philippine-American Educational Foundation (PAEF) Board, I am pleased to congratulate you on your Fulbright award in the Philippines. The award comes from the J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board (FSB), the Department of State, and the PAEF Board. It is administered in cooperation with the Institute of International Education (IIE). The award is contingent upon your obtaining satisfactory medical clearance from the Department of State.

The FSB, composed of twelve educational and public leaders appointed by the President of the United States, has statutory responsibility under the Mutual Educational and Cultural Exchange Act of 1961 (Fulbright-Hays Act) for the selection of all Fulbright grantees and the supervision of the Fulbright Program worldwide, including the formulation of policy guidelines governing the exchanges.

The Department of State administers the Fulbright program with the assistance of binational commissions and foundations in some 51 countries that have executive agreements with the United States for continuing exchange programs, United States embassies in approximately 85 other countries, and a number of cooperating agencies, including IIE. In the Philippines, the program is administered by PAEF.

Enclosed is your Fulbright Grant Authorization (three copies) which contains the terms and conditions of the award. Please review the provisions contained in the Authorization. Indicate your acceptance of the grant by signing all three copies of the Authorization. Bring to PAEF the last two copies of the Grant Authorization during your orientation at the PAEF office on July 27, 2015.


Your award is for the period of July 25, 2015 to April 24, 2016 (9) months. The award covers the following: (1) round-trip international travel, (budget economy class); (2) excess baggage allowance US Dollars 470 plus \$30 wire transfer charges (maximum); (3) monthly maintenance allowance, USD 1,000; (4) relocation allowance, USD 750; (5) books/tuition, USD 1,000; (6) in-country travel, USD 1,000; (7) language training allowance USD150; and (8) health and accident insurance coverage.

Further program and administrative details of the award will be described in subsequent communications.
