Notice is hereby given that the School Safety and Security Committee of Divide Independent School District will hold a regular meeting at the date, time, and place stated above. The meeting is open to the public and is subject to the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code. The Committee may meet in closed (executive) session on any item as authorized by that chapter.

OPEN SESSION

1. Call to order, establishment of a quorum, and record of attendance.
2. Introduction of committee members and confirmation of committee membership required by Texas Education Code § 37.109 (board representative, campus administrator, classroom teacher, parent(s), district staff, and local law enforcement).
3. Public comment / open forum.
4. Approval of minutes from the previous committee meeting.
5. Review of the committee's purpose, duties, and meeting requirements under Texas Education Code § 37.109 (committee meets at least once each semester and once during the summer).

CLOSED (EXECUTIVE) SESSION

The Committee will convene in closed (executive) session to develop, deliberate, and formulate recommendations on the matters below, as authorized by the Texas Open Meetings Act. Because these deliberations reveal security methods, facility vulnerabilities, security-audit results, and the deployment of security personnel and devices, they are confidential and are conducted in closed session. No vote or final action will be taken in closed session.

6. **Develop and implement campus emergency plans consistent with the District Multihazard Emergency Operations Plan (MEOP) to ensure the plans reflect specific campus, facility, and support-services needs.**

7. **Deliberate and formulate recommendations to the Board of Trustees and district administration regarding updates to the District Multihazard Emergency Operations Plan in accordance with best practices.**

8. **Review each report the District is required to submit to the Texas School Safety Center (TxSSC) to ensure it contains accurate and complete information for each campus, facility, and support service.**

9. **Review the District's safety and security audit and the TEA/TxSSC vulnerability assessment — findings, vulnerabilities, and required corrective actions (confidential report).**

- 10. Deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel, critical infrastructure, or security devices at district facilities.**

- 11. Deliberate security assessments or deployments relating to information resources technology, and network security information.**

- 12. Consult with local law enforcement regarding methods to increase law enforcement presence at or near district campuses.**

- 13. Review the status of required safety drills and exercises (fire/evacuation, lockdown, shelter-in-place, reverse evacuation, and reunification) and any vulnerabilities identified.**

Examples of security devices and matters that may be discussed in closed session: door access-control and locking hardware, camera / video surveillance placement, silent panic-alert technology and communication systems, fencing and vehicle barriers, alarm and intrusion-detection systems, and the location and deployment of any security personnel.

- 15. Action, motions, and votes, if any, on the committee's recommendations to the Board of Trustees and on matters deliberated in closed session (all votes and final action are taken in open session).**
- 16. Set date and agenda topics for the next committee meeting.**
