

Gayle Leon Vanderzanden, 82, a resident of the Cornelius community passed away on June 14, 2024 at Volante Senior Living of Hillsboro.

Gayle was born on October 22, 1941 in Forest Grove, OR. He was the oldest son born to Andrew and Theresa (Cropp) Vanderzanden. He was raised on the family dairy farm in Forest Grove and attended Forest Grove High School.

He enlisted into the US Army Reserve in 1962 and discharged in 1966.

Gayle met his future wife, Esther Smith, while in high school. At the time they didn't start dating until much later in life. Esther reunited with Gayle at the Coffee Grinder in Forest Grove in the mid 1970's, they soon began dating, moved in with each other and married on June 30, 1985 at the Coffee Grinder in Forest Grove. They lived in California from early 1980's until 1985 when they moved to Forest Grove and then in 2017 moved to Gaston, OR. In 2020 they moved to Cornelius.

He was an owner operator of Gayles Floors, a company he ran with his partner, Neil Dames from 1966 to 1998. He was also co-owner of the Coffee Grinder from 1970 to 1990.

Gayle played billiards and was on several league teams, he loved to socialize with his group of friends and family. He was an avid sport fisherman crabbing, clamming and ocean fishing. He played golf and was an excellent cook. Gayle enjoyed traveling with his wife Esther in their RV. They traveled for over 15 years throughout the US Canada and Mexico.

Gayle was a life member of the Eagles, Elks and Moose and enjoyed his memberships in the American Legion and VFW. He is preceded in death by his parents, a son, Kevin Vanderzanden and his spouse, Barbara, Bill Rus and his spouse Peggy.

He is survived by his loving wife, Esther, two children and their spouses, Karla Doering of Tualatin, Toni Kyffin of Beaverton, a daughter-in-law, Ruth Vanderzanden of Gales Creek, two step children and their spouses, Michelle Bowman and Joe Davis of Rainier, OR, Michael and Christina Bowman of Cornelius, a special daughter and her spouse, Carol and Paul Banach of Bradenton, FL.
