Vote for One		<input type="radio"/> Matthew Detjen		The board of Independent School District No, 727 (Big Lake), Minnesota has proposed to renew its capital project levy authorization expiring after taxes payable in 2025 in the maximum amount of 3.207% times the net tax capacity of the school district. The proposed tax rate is not being increased from the previous year's rate. The proposed renewal of the expiring capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$930,816 for taxes first levied in 2025, payable in 2026 and will be authorized for ten (10) years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$9,308,160. The proposed renewal will provide funds for school district technology, including the purchase, installation, replacement, support and maintenance of software, technology, technology systems, technology infrastructure, and digital curriculum, and to pay the costs of technology related personnel and training.
